Who's eligible to join the pool?

Anyone and everyone (members of participating NCAA programs might want to consider carefully, though ;-)).

What are the requirements?

The only requirements are that the \$10 entry fee is paid before the round of 16 games have begun, and that the pertinent entry information is received before the start of the tournament. The pertinent entry information would include:

- Real name
- Preferred nickname (I am the Mighty Mobelfakta, so that name's taken already).
- Prediction for the total combined score of the championship game (for tie-breaking purposes).
- Predicted winners of all 63 tournament games.

How are the points scored?

- 2 points for each 1st round win
- 3 points for each 2nd round win
- 4 points for each 3rd round win
- 6 points for each 4th round win
- 8 points for each 5th round win
- 12 points for correctly picking the NCAA Champion

There is no weighting for "upsets".

How is the prize money distributed?

Last year with 36 entries, there was a first, second, third, and fourth place prize. The \$360.00 pot was split as follows: 1st-\$180.00, 2nd-\$90.00, 3rd-\$60.00, and 4th-\$30.00. This year the money will be split with roughly the same proportions going to the winners.

What if there's a tie?

The participant whose prediction comes closest (higher or lower) for the final combined score of the championship game will win the tie-breaker. If there is STILL a tie, the money will be split. For instance, if there is a tie for first place, the winners will split the combined prize money for first and second place. FYI, in five years of running this pool, there has only been one tie for prize money.

Can I enter more than once?

You certainly can. Statistically, your chances of winning would double. However, so far of the four people (eight entries) that have tried their luck with two entries, only one has taken home any prize money. Go figure.

1. The most convenient method of entry for those with internet access would be the web entry form which can be accessed [here](#). Otherwise, get thee a copy of the NCAA Men's Tournament Bracket. The most convenient place to get one would be the sports section of your local newspaper. You can also get the brackets at various sports related web sites ([ESPN](#), [FinalFour.net](#), [CBS Sportsline](#), etc.). If you are planning to enter online via this web site, skip to step 6 below.

2. Fill out the brackets completely using all the college basketball wisdom you can conjure up.

3. Make a prediction for the total combined score for the championship game. For instance, if you think the final score will be 82-76, your prediction would be 158.

4. Create a nickname for yourself. This is important, because if you don't give us one, we'll make one up for you. Historically, these assigned nicknames have not been flattering.

5. Send all that precious information this-away before the first game on Thursday, March 16. Obviously, the fastest way to get the info here is by e-mail (dfeng@hwci.com and smt2@hwci.com). However, you can also send it via snail mail, so long as it is post marked by March 16th. Those going the e-mail route will have to manually type in all your picks. The most efficient way of completing this tedious task is to send in your picks as follows:

LA MIRADA/ROSEMEAD, CA (smt)- #11E-Pepperdine rolled over

#6E-Indiana for just the third lower seeded victory in this tourney.

Last year 12 lower-seeded teams won. Although this year's bunch have put up some good fights, they have mostly come up empty. This was the first time in 12 years a #12 seed didn't win a First Round game (#12MW-St. Bonaventure and #12E-Bulter came oh, so close).

#10E-Seton Hall blew a 10-point lead (57-47) and needed overtime to send #7E-Oregon packing thanks to Shaheen Holloway's end-to-end layup

(reminiscent of Tyus Edney's play for UCLA in 1995). #5E-Florida rallied from a 6-point deficit, then needed two LaVall Jordan missed free throws and a buzzer-beating basket in overtime to hold off #12E-Butler. #4S-Tennessee fought off a determined #13-Louis.-Lafayette team. #4E-Illinois and #5-UConn held off their opponents while #2E-Temple, #7S-Tulsa, and #2S-Cincy routed theirs.

How do you blow a 6-pt lead in overtime when you have the ball? You step out of bounds. #8E-Kansas scored the last 10 points in overtime to stun #9E-DePaul. All the other games were pretty much blowouts as #1E-Duke, #3E-Oklahoma St., #1S-Stanford, #8S-North Carolina, #6S-Miami(OH), and #3S-Ohio St. cruised to victories.

Kansas' OT win gave MONEY (1st, 60) his 27th victory, a HWCI-record for the 1st Round. Indiana foiled MONEY's perfect day and shares the lead with MORALES' MOUNDS (1st, 60). TENNESSEE HIGHEST SEED LEFT STANDING IN SOUTH AS STANFORD FALLS

In 48 hours, Money goes from first to one of 13 eliminated from pool

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- If you thought the West was in disarray after yesterday, the South topped it as #1S-Stanford, #2S-Cincy, and #3S-Ohio St. all fell leaving #4S-Tennessee, #6S-Miami(FL), #7S-Tulsa, and #8S-UNC remaining for a spot in the Final Four. The East fared a little better but lost #2E-Temple and #4E-Illinois. Whereas the First Round saw the higher seeded team win 29 of 32 games, they won less than half of the Second Round games (7 of 16).

UNC, who many thought shouldn't have made the tournament,

outplayed top seed Stanford, 60-53, for their 30th straight 20-win season. UNC ended the first half on an 8-0 run to lead 28-27. Cincinnati, arguably the best team in the country before star Kenyon Martin was injured, couldn't keep up with Tulsa, 69-61. This was the fourth straight year Cincy failed to get to the Sweet Sixteen (third time as a #2 seed, once as #3 seed). Miami of Fla. broke open a close game to take care of Ohio St., 75-62. UConn joined Ohio St. in failing to make the Final Four for the 2nd straight year in losing to Tennessee, spoiling another UConn-Ohio St. matchup.

#1E-Duke struggled all day against #8E-Kansas before winning 69-64. #10E-Seton Hall, playing most of the game without the injured Holloway, won their second consecutive overtime game, 67-65, over Temple. #5E-Florida routed #4E-Illinois, 93-76. #11E-Pepperdine who blazed by Indiana with good shooting and 3-pt shots, went cold (7 of 32 3-pt attempts) and lost to #3E-Oklahoma St., 75-67.

MORALES' MOUNDS (1st, 84) regained the lead in a day that saw everyone's picks take major hits. MMOUNDS got only four right but it tied the high and he is now in sole possession of first.

ALSTAR (8th-3rd, 77) picked 9 of 16 in the Second Round. DEREK

FINISHER WANNABE (23rd, 71) who set a record low of 2 wins yesterday and tied this year's low of 5 wins in the Second Round, still has a chance to win 1st Place. MONEY (14th-Elim, 75) who had a record 60 points after the First Round is one of 13 entries who can't win any money. Just three people picked Seton Hall's win and just four picked Miami(FL). In addition to the five upsets today, 22 picked UConn over Tennessee (11) incorrectly. Everyone picked Duke and 24 picked Oklahoma St. Just 14 people remain for the fight for the top prize of \$180.

LA MIRADA/EL SEGUNDO, CA (smt)- Just two of the six rounds of the

NCAA Tournament have been completed but already thirteen will be

pondering what went wrong for the next two weekends. The Possibilities

list is out and it shows PATTO (6th, 78) with a 36.84% chance of winning first place and over 50% chance of winning any money. The

current leader, MORALES' MOUNDS (1st, 84), has an almost 80% chance of

winning any money but only a 28.71% of winning first. Twelve others

still have their eye on the first place prize of \$180 while 21 more

will hope to profit from this pool. THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA (3rd, 80)

and JACKASS (2nd, 82) are the other two with a greater than 50% chance of winning money (54.27% and 52.25%, respectively).

LUIS ENRIQUE'S ARMY (23rd-4, 71) has the lowest percentage of winning any money at 0.15% (48 of 32,768 possibilities).

PATTO is one of two people with 3 of their Final Four teams still alive as most people have taken hits with Arizona, St. John's, Stanford, and Temple getting early exits. BASTOSBINATA (69) is the other which is why he can still win first despite being in 30th place. LUCKYFROMSF (67) sits in 32nd place but still has a slim chance to take first because he has LSU making the Final and Iowa St. making the Final Four. In fact, those having Iowa St., Florida, Syracuse, LSU, UCLA, or Tennessee making the Final Four have a chance for 1st. With JAYBIAN IV (30th, 69) eliminated and JEBUS (19th-3, 73) can't finishing higher than 3rd, it just leaves BIGSPIDERBECK (27th, 70) with a chance to become the first person to win the HWCI NCAA pool twice (he won in 1995).

Two days ago it looked like we were going to see record numbers put up by our participants as new highs were established. Now, the 148 points put up by BIX PIX in 1995 will remain as no one will finish higher than 140. This year's Second Round was the worst in HWCI NCAA history (ALSTAR (8th-3, 77) had the high with 9 of 16

correct) after following the best First Round in HWCI NCAA history.

Only one person (BASTOSBINATA) has more than 4 possible correct teams in Elite 8 and for the sixth straight year, no one will predict all 4 Final Four teams correctly. Just 17 have their champion in the tourney and 9 have their two Finalists still alive.

Seven more entries fall as Morales' Mounds zeros in on a money spot

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The West final will feature two surprising

Big 10 teams while the Midwest will feature the two top seeds which

includes Big 10 champion #1MW-Michigan St. There were no close

games as three Big 10 teams advanced to the Elite 8.

Michigan St. rallied from a 14-point 2nd half deficit (40-26) and

closed out the game on a 17-0 run in the last 5:54 to beat #4MW-Syracuse,

75-58. Michigan St. was 9 for 15 from 3 point range in the second half.

#6MW-UCLA left their game in Minneapolis and got crushed by #2MW-Iowa St.,

80-56. It was Iowa St.'s first-ever win over UCLA (1-6). This will be the only regional where the top two teams will meet for the chance to go to the Final Four in Indianapolis.

What could've been a great game turned out to be a relatively easy victory for #6W-Purdue over #10W-Gonzaga, 75-66. #8W-Wisconsin played *their* game and forced 23 #4W-LSU turnovers to win 61-48. LSU tried to rally late with a 9-0 run but it was too late as Wisconsin hit their free throws. The West will feature a #6 seed and a #8 seed for a trip to the Final Four.

In the pool, the Michigan St. rally sent NO CAL? (31st-e, 72) and DEREK FISHER WANNABE (32nd-e, 71) out of contention and bumped FLYINGELVI (17th-4, 79) to no higher than 4th. UCLA's loss sent homer BIGSPIDERBECK (28th-e, 74), JAFMAN (7th-2, 84) [*Not eliminated; no higher than 2nd. smt*], CARSERONI (16th-e, 80) and ALSTAR (14th-e, 81) down the tubes and bumped CRIAGS99 (12th-2, 82) to possible high of 2nd place. Wisconsin's impressive victory sent two more home (LUIS ENRIQUE'S ARMADA (17th-e, 79) and LUCKYFROMSF (26th-e, 75) and dropped FREE FABONE (7th-3, 84) to no higher than 3rd and BASTOSBINATA (23rd-4, 77) to no higher than 4th.

In the worst Thursday 3rd Round ever, 20 entries were 2-2 for the day and three went 0 for 4. In the one pool battle, SLINKY DUDE's (34th-e, 69) Purdue pick beat BETHEON's (36th-e, 62) Gonzaga pick. BETHEON will now need Duke to make the Final Four to avoid claiming the worst entry ever (TRUE BRUIN (1999) with 67 points). She already is guaranteed the 2nd-worst entry ever. Thirty people picked Michigan St. and 22 picked Iowa St. Nine people who picked LSU saw their chance to gain four points disappear. If you picked all the favorites, you'd sit in 5th place with 87 points. PATTO (21st, 78) who went 0-4 today still has a chance for first.

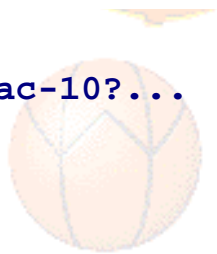

Morales' Mounds secures money spot and a 90% chance of first place

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The bracket gets messier and messier as

a #3, #5, #7, and #8 seed advanced to the Regional Finals. There are only two #1 or #2 seeds in the Elite 8. The state of Oklahoma went 2-0 today and the state of Florida went 1-1.

#1E-Duke's freshmen mistakes helped a young #5E-Florida defeat the #1 team in the country, 87-78. Like Michigan St. did yesterday, Florida closed the game on a 13-0 run. Duke had won 26 straight

East Regional games in a row. #3E-Oklahoma St. held off #10E-Seton Hall, 68-62.

The battle of the "Hurricanes" was won by #7S-Tulsa. The Golden Hurricane beat the #6S-Miami (FL) Hurricanes, 80-71. #8S-North Carolina had a 13-0 run late in the game to beat #4S-Tennessee, 74-69.

Duke's loss totally changed the face of the pool. It:

- Assured MORALES' MOUNDS (1st-\$1/2, 96) of a money spot
- Assured BETHEON (36th-e, 62) of the worst-finish ever
- Narrowed down the 1st place finishers to 4 people
- Eliminated three more from money contention (FREE FABONE

(10th-e, 84), BASTOSBINATA (17th-e, 81), FLYINGELVI (21st-e, 79))

Tulsa's win eliminated BINGO41 (8th-e, 85) and Oklahoma St.'s win eliminated MAD MANDO (10th-e, 84) and defending pool champion JEBUS (17th-e, 81). MAD MANDO had a horrible day as he found out in succession that he couldn't win 2nd (Florida's win), 3rd (Tulsa's win), or 4th (OSU's win). Just 10 are left for the money spots and MORALES' MOUNDS has clinched at least 1st or 2nd.

PATTO (14th, 82) is the only challenger to MOUNDS for 1st and that will need at least a Florida championship.

It continues to be a horrendous pool as no one has more than one team (besides CALIGATOR (12th-2, 83)) left in their Final Four. Five have none. Of the eight teams left, only two (six with Michigan St. and one with Florida) have been picked by the 36 entries. CALIGATOR was the only person to get 2 right today and 24 went 0 for 4. Overall in the Sweet Sixteen, seven picked 3 of 8 (a record low) and 13 went 1 for 8. Still, the 96 points M.MOUNDS has is not the lowest point total after the 3rd Round (88 by SHARY BOBBINS in 1999).

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- #1MW-Michigan St. and #2MW-Iowa St. played

a championship-caliber game with Michigan St. once again showing its reserve by rallying from a 7-point deficit (59-52) with 5:49 left to win by 11, 75-64. This game was marked by horrible referees (double foul? ticky tack fouls late in the game? violations missed and suddenly violations called?) and resulted in the ejection of Cyclone coach Larry Eustachy with gave the Spartans six free throws to end the game. The keys? The Spartans hit 22 of 24 free throws, forced 19 Cyclone turnovers, and won despite being outrebounded,

MORALES' MOUNDS (1st-\$, 102) topped the century mark and will have to await the Florida-OSU result before he finds out if he will be assured of winning the \$180 top prize. He will at least take 2nd (\$90). THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA (3rd-2, 94) will at least finish fourth in points but could lose the tiebreaker for fourth in some scenarios. 26 went 1-1 for the day and no one will do better than 1-3 for the Fourth Round, another low.

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The 2000 Final Four, the last of this

century, begins this Saturday with Big 10 rivals #1MW-Michigan St.

(30-7) and #8W-Wisconsin (22-13) in the first game in Indianapolis.

The Spartans (8-pt favorites) have started slowly in each of their games and needing to rally in their last two games. It may prove

tough if the game is close against the methodical defense of Wisconsin. However, the Badgers have only lost three games since February 2nd- all to Michigan St. The second game will feature explosive #5E-Florida (28-7) versus surprising #8S-North Carolina (22-13). If the Gators offense is only semi-hot, they could wear down the Tar Heels.

From the FinalFour.net homepage at the *start* of the tourney:

* MICHIGAN ST. OUTLOOK: Michigan State might be the most feared team entering the Big Dance. The Spartans have the experience, talent and confidence to be national champions and have to be one of the favorites in the NCAA Tournament.

* WISCONSIN OUTLOOK: The Badgers don't have the weapons for a serious run in the NCAA Tournament. Look for Wisconsin to make an early exit.

* FLORIDA OUTLOOK: The Gators have a realistic chance to get to the Sweet 16 and if facing the right opponent, advance to the final eight. But the Gators are probably one year away from a trip to the Final Four and a shot at a national title.

* NORTH CAROLINA OUTLOOK: The individual talent of North Carolina's players should give the Tar Heels a victory in the first

round, but their relatively low seed and inconsistencies on both ends of the court will make it difficult for this team to go deep in the NCAA Tournament. A better UNC team lost in the first round last year to Weber State.

In the pool, both games will be watched carefully by the six people still in the running (MORALES' MOUNDS having wrapped up either 1st or 2nd). A Spartan win will doom JAFMAN and keep THE FABONE IV and CRAIGS99's hopes alive. PATTO will need the Gators to advance for any chance of a money spot. JACKASS would be assured of money if the Spartans lose but would still be okay with a win. THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA will be guaranteed money with a Florida loss or Michigan St. win.

CRAIGS99 (5th-4, 100) can still win 4th if Michigan St. wins on Monday which would bump JACKASS (2nd-3, 104) out of the money picture. Twenty-four people picked up one win (23 for Michigan St., 1 for Florida) in trying to salvage a topsy-turvy pool. For the second straight year, at least one person will pick the correct NCAA champion with 13 picking the Spartans and PATTO picking the Gators. Five more people topped the century mark but FLYINGELVI (31st-e, 79) and BIGSPIDERBECK's (35th-e, 74) streak of five consecutive 100+ point pools came to an end.

MORALES' MOUNDS BECOMES SIXTH DIFFERENT HWCI POOL CHAMPION

Six years have produced at least 15 winners splitting \$1,530

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The 6th HWCI NCAA Tournament Pool will

produce its 6th different champion, as Sam N (aka, MORALES' MOUNDS)

will take home the \$180 1st Place prize. Arguably the most

unpredictable tournament, the first round gave no sign of it as

25 entries went at least 26-6 in the first round. Then no one got

more than 9 of 16 2nd Round games correct; no one got more than 3 of

8 3rd Round games correct; and no one got more than 1 of 4 4th Round

games correct. Three of the four Final Four teams MORALES' MOUNDS picked never made it out of the 2nd Round but was able to ride Michigan St.'s road to the Final thanks to Duke's loss in the Sweet Sixteen. Scott T (THE FABONE VI) won 3rd in 1998 and 2nd in 1999 and will try to win 3rd in 2000 if Michigan St. wins. Dave F (THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA) will once again take home money after finishing 3rd in the first year of the pool (1995). The pool, from its modest beginnings in 1995 when just 12 people participated, has tripled in size with a pot of \$360.

A little history.....

In 1995, the first year of the pool, just 12 people entered in a modest effort put forth by HW-UCLA and their close friends. Names

like BAD ASS and LIVER BOY graced the pool. Of course, their interest was heightened because UCLA was favored to win it all. Indeed, 10 of 12 picked UCLA while 2 picked Kentucky. This pool featured the infamous LOSER WHO DIDN'T PICK UCLA (Dennis K) who set an all-time record with a 14-2 2nd Round to go from tied for 9th to tied for 1st before going 0-7 in the final 3 rounds to finish dead last (12th) with 98 points. TINA'S BOY (Mark C) became the first

person to be eliminated when the 2nd round ended. He is, however, one of only 3 people (all in 1995) to correctly pick the two teams in the final and the champion. BIX PIX (Fernando B, 1st, 148) and MR. NELSON (Nelson, 2nd, 146) were the other two and claimed the top two spots, winning \$70 and \$30, respectively. THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA (Dave F, 3rd, 141) claimed third prize worth \$20. All but one finished with 110 points or more, the highest scoring pool ever (130.6 average).

In 1996, 19 people participated in the pool. Without the HW-UCLA guys picking nicknames, we had some boring stuff like JAMES, JOSEPH, and HEATHER. That year, the total points tiebreaker was first used to settle ties. A newcomer, JAYBIAN (Jason S, 1st, 144) rode Kentucky to a first place prize of \$110. He also set a record going 8-0 for the 3rd round and never looked back. BIX PIX TWEY (Fernando B, 5th, 129) hoping to duplicate last year's effort, fell short of winning money thanks to his loyalty to UCLA. JOSEPH (Joseph K, 2nd, 140) and JAMES (James L, 3rd, 139) won \$50 and \$30, respectively. Six picked Kentucky that year with just as many picking UCLA (who lost to Princeton in the first round- ouch!). This was the first year someone entered twice (Dave F) and ended up 11th (REALISTIC MOBELFAKTA, 113) and 16th (THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA, 106). MM and HATE THE DUCKS

(Mark C, 12th, 112) became the 2nd and 3rd people to go 0-for-the-Final-Four. HATE THE DUCKS had a 64% chance of winning money heading into the 4th round, and 0% chance after. THE CHEF (Douglas H, 19th, 80) set an all-time low in points for a pool.

In 1997, the first real debate on whether to raise the pool fee to \$20 from \$10 was raised. Fortunately, it was defeated in a vote. But, three people did plunk down \$20 to enter twice as 22 entries were received in the third annual pool. Like Dave F before them, the three people went moneyless (Tuan H- RODERICK (15th, 97) and RHODES (14th, 97); Alvin K- BAD ASS I (4th, 111) and BAD ASS II (18th, 93); and Dennis K- LENNY (6th, 107) and DUKE (12th, 99)). This was also the first year no one picked the correct NCAA champion. Arizona, who usually bowed out in the first or second round, surprised everyone, including Kentucky, in winning the championship in overtime. The #4SE seed beat three # 1 seeds, the first time that's happened. Twelve had picked Kansas and four North Carolina, neither which made the championship game. MAX (Sean D, 1st, 116) bounced back from a 15th place finish the year before to win the \$125 top prize. The brothers Selander took 2nd (Brian S, THE FLYING ELVI, 2nd, 115) and 3rd (Jason S, JAYBIAN II, 3rd, 113) for \$60 and \$35,

respectively. Jason S became the first person to win money twice (1st in 1996). Just half (11 of 22) finished 100 points or higher.

In 1998, a record 28 entries tried their luck. ANNA COME LATELY (Anna, 1st, 126), the last entry we received, seemed like the least likely to win, picking a Utah over UCLA final. Well, Utah surprised the 27 other entrants (no one else even had them in the Final Four) and gave ANNA COME LATELY the record top prize of \$150. James L became the 2nd person to win twice taking the \$70 second place prize (CAVEMAN, 2nd, 113) while THE FABONE (Scott T, 3rd, 110) won money for the first time in four tries to take home \$40. For the first time, a 4th place prize was created and that went to SCOTTMAN (Scott H, 4th, 108), which was also the first time the tiebreaker played a part in the top spots as SCOTTMAN won the 4-way tie for 4th place. With Kentucky's rally and win over Utah in the final, this was the 2nd straight year no one picked the champion. Sixteen pegged UNC while five hoped for an Arizona repeat. UTHOPE (Donald G, 24th, 92) became the 4th person to go 0-7 in the last three rounds. ANNA COME LATELY's 13-point win was the largest margin of victory ever.

Tuan H once again entered twice with the same results- no money (STRAIGHT BUTTER, 10th, 106 and EN FUEGO, 13th, 104) extending the

drought for dual entries to 0-for-5.

In 1999, a record 36 entries (18 NCAA pool newcomers, 13 pool newcomers if you include those who participated in the World Cup Pool) were received with two dual entries (Scott T- THE FABONE V and FREE FABONE and Gareth M- CARSERONI and MAJERUS FOR SDSU). Mark C (DARKSHARK) became the first person to go 0-for-7 in the Final Four twice (1996). SHARY BOBBINS (Lisa T, 1st, 146) and CARSERONI (Gareth M, 3rd, 120) became the 12th and 13th different people to win HWC NCAA pool money. Scott T (FREE FABONE) and Gareth M (CARSERONI) broke a streak of winless dual entries with a 2nd and 3rd Place finish in one of their entries. James L (BIG GAME, 5th, 117) bid to go 3-for-3 in winning money came falling down with Duke's stunning loss. Three of four people who picked UConn (29 picked Duke) to win it all won money. Fernando B (BIG SPIDER BECK, 4th, 118) had just a 4 in 132 chance to win money and took 4th, his second winning entry ever. Loretta A (TRUE BRUIN, 36th, 67) finished with all-time record low in points.

In 2000, a record-tying 36 entries once again tried their luck as 14 newcomers entered. Sam N (MORALES' MOUNDS) becomes the sixth different champion after finishing 26th and 31st in the previous

two years. He became the first person to either be tied or in the lead after each of the six rounds. After a record breaking first round

that saw two people get 30 of 32 first round games correct, the brackets started to fall apart as no one got more than 3 of 8 Sweet Sixteen games correct and eight people will go 0-7 in the Final Four (just six have done so before (117 entries)). Just one #1 and one #2 seed advanced to the Elite Eight. Dave F (THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA) returns to the winner's circle with at least a 4th Place finish. Scott T (FREE FABONE and THE FABONE VI) will try to do what James L couldn't do the year before- win money in three straight pools. Beth S (BETHEON, 36th, 62) shattered the all-time low in points. Will newcomer Patrick C (PATTO) become the lone correct predictor of Florida's championship or will the fourteen who pegged Michigan St. as champions win out? Will first-time predictors Michael K (JACKASS) and Craig E (CRAIGS99) take home some money? We'll find out Monday.

MICHIGAN ST. OVERCLASSES FLORIDA FOR 2ND NCAA TITLE, 89-76

The Fabone VI wins money for third straight year

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The seniors of #1MW-Michigan St. shook

off the freshmen and sophomores of #5E-Florida, 89-76, in the RCA

Dome in Indianapolis. The Spartans had a scare when star guard

Martin Cleaves went down with a twisted ankle with 16:18 left and

up by six. Michigan St. held on and built an 8-point lead when Cleaves came back igniting the Spartan's morale and energy as they outscored the Gators 24-12 to build an insurmountable 20-point lead. Cleaves did not do much after the injury but Florida could not capitalize despite getting some good inside shots with their big men. The Spartans win their 2nd NCAA title (the first in 1979 with Magic Johnson) in their last real hope as the team will rebuild next year. Florida, on the other hand, will be a formidable force as their youngsters build on this experience.

Michigan St.'s win sent JACKASS (10th, 104) and PATTO (18th, 96) out of the money picture and put THE FABONE VI (3rd, 113) and CRAIGS99 (4th, 112) in. THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA (2nd, 114) moved up to 2nd Place as the pool champion MORALES' MOUNDS (1st, 122) looked on. Despite a HWCI record thirteen people picking the correct champion, this was the lowest scoring pool ever (94.7 pts per entry (first time average under 100.0)). Scott T becomes the first person to win money in three straight pools (four, if you include the 1998 HWCI World Cup Pool) after going winless in the first three. THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA returns to the money spot for the second time (2nd in 1995), becoming the fifth 2-time winner. MORALES' MOUNDS wins in his third try while CRAIGS99 wins on his first try. MORALES' MOUNDS also became the first

person to win or tie for points in each round as well as the first person to lead or tie after each round (tied after the first round and sole possession of first after that). Scott T's money spot extends the streak to three of people who have entered twice and won something (prior to that it was 0 for 5).

INDIANAPOLIS (AP) -- This time there was no Magic, just Mateen. Michigan State, with Magic Johnson cheering in the stands, won its second national championship as Mateen Cleaves led the Spartans to an 89-76 victory over Florida.

It was 21 years ago that the championship game between Michigan State and Indiana State -- Magic vs. Bird -- changed the landscape of college basketball.

This one may not have the magnitude, but it had the drama thanks to Cleaves, the Spartans' limping leader, who needed crutches for his injured ankle after celebrating with his teammates.

"He has the heart of a lion. He has done it for four years, not just one," Michigan State coach Tom Izzo said. "That's why you love him. He's what our program embodies."

Cleaves rolled his ankle early in the second half and had to go to the locker room. Earlier, he helped the Spartans build a 43-32 halftime lead by scoring 13 points, including going 3-for-3 from 3-point range, and negated Florida's vaunted full-court pressure with his ballhandling and passing.

"I told them he'll be back. Let's not get our heads down," Izzo said. "I just knew."

When Cleaves left with 16:18 to play the Spartans led 50-44. His teammates got the lead to 58-50 by the time he returned 4:29 later. But the senior guard who missed the first 13 games of the season while recovering from a stress fracture in his right foot, was again the team's emotional leader.

His long pass to Morris Peterson for a layup made it 60-50. He was leveled while setting a screen a few minutes later but it was enough to spring A.J. Granger for a 3-pointer that started a 16-6 run that made it 84-66 and put the game away.

Michigan State had been on a mission since losing to Duke in the Final Four last season. Anything short of a national championship would have been a disappointment.

"We made some promises. We answered the promises," Izzo said.

Cleaves certainly didn't beat Florida by himself.

Peterson finished with 21 points on 7-for-14 shooting and Granger had 19 and was 7-for-11 from the field.

Cleaves was 7-for-11 from the field -- all the shots coming before he was injured -- and had 18 points and four assists.

Cleaves returned for his senior year after many thought he would go to the NBA.

"This is what I came back here for," he said.

"This is as storybook as it gets for Mateen," Izzo said. "He gave up a lot of money, a lot of things to be back here."

The Spartans (32-7), the only top-seeded team to reach the Final Four, finished 33-for-59 from the field (56 percent), the best against Florida's frantic pace by far in the tournament. The previous best was 43 percent by top-ranked Duke in the regional semifinals.
