As instituted by Andy, Fern, and Dave of HW-UCLA, fees are \$10. The winner is the person who collects the most points. Point values are as follows: Two (2) points for each FIRST ROUND game winner correctly picked (32 games/64 points possible); Three (3) points for each SECOND ROUND game winner picked (16/48); Four (4) points for each ROUND OF 16 game winner picked (8/32); Six (6) points for correctly picking each team making the FINAL FOUR in Seattle (4/24); Eight (8) points for correctly picking each team making it to the CHAMPIONSHIP GAME (2/16); and Twelve (12) points for correctly picking the 1995 NCAA NATIONAL CHAMPION (1/12). There are a total of 63 games (196 points).

There are twelve (12) participants for a pool of \$120 (before Andy and Dave embezzle their fair share;-)). FIRST PLACE wins \$70.00; SECOND PLACE wins \$30.00; and THIRD PLACE wins \$20.00. Very quickly, here are the essentials to the pool. Only five people are still in the running for any money: *Mr. Nelson, Lil' Saigon, Bix Pix, The Fabone*, and *The Mighty Mobelfakta. Everyone picked UCLA to win the 1995 NCAA Championship except for *Traitor Jen* and *Loser Who Didn't Pick UCLA* (who went 0-4 for the Fourth Round), where the both picked Kentucky to win it all. No one picked all four finalists (although three picked three of four) but eight people have a chance to get both of their teams in the Championship on Monday. *Traitor Jen* had the worst luck, as when Villanove got knocked out in the First Round, she automatcially lost 23 points. *Lil' Saigon* had the best luck, as despite finishing last inthe First Round and having both Arizona (1st Round) and U.Mass eliminated (4th Round) prior to the Final Four, still has a chance for Third Place.

1995 National Championship Recap

Even though the 1995 championship game was not a rematch of any kind, it certainly had two teams that were accustomed to playing for the national title. The UCLA Bruins were making their 15th trip to the Final Four and looking for their 11th title, while the Arkansas Razorbacks were making their fifth trip to the Final Four and looking for back-to-back crowns. Their title search proved elusive, as UCLA captured an 89-78 victory before 38,540 spectators at the Kingdome in Seattle, Washington.

UCLA took the title in style as senior forward Ed O'Bannon (30 points), the championship's most outstanding player, and freshman Toby Bailey combined to scored 56 points to lead the Bruins to the victory despite playing without senior point guard Tyus Edney. The Bruins' playmaker logged only three minutes of playing time before being removed with an injured hand.

UCLA took a 40-39 lead with 10 seconds remaining in the first half and never relinquished it, as the Bruins held off a second half charge for the win.

Clint McDaniel led Arkansas with 16 points all of which came in the first half of play.


