Friends and Friends of Friends,

You are officially invited to join the 3rd annual HWCI NCAA Tournament Pool. Now, as you wait for the chills down your spine to subside, here's some pertinent information to digest:

The pool is open to all who are interested, so feel free to forward this e-mail to others. The entry fee is $\$ 10$, and the picks are due next Wednesday, March 12. The entry payment deadline is flexible. Basically, if you were invited to join, we know you're good for the 10 bucks, so don't sweat it. The tournament seedings will be released Sunday, March 9. The scoring is weighted by round and not by seeds, so picking underdogs correctly will give you the same amount of points as picking the favorite correctly. Of course, by picking a low seed victory correctly, you will be getting points that most entrants won't, so it still may be worth it. The point distribution hasn't been finalized, but it shouldn't effect your strategy. The last two years the points have been awarded as follows:
2 points for each 1st round win
3 points for each 2nd round win
4 points for each 3rd round win
6 points for each 4th round win
8 points for each 5th round win
12 points for picking the NCAA Champion
There will be a first, second, and third place prize. Last year, we had $\$ 190$ in the pot, first place winning $\$ 110$, second place winning $\$ 50$, and third place taking $\$ 30$. This year's prizes will be distributed along the same line.

There are two ways to send us your picks:

1) If you think you're computer literate, there is software available for both the Mac and Windows for you to use to send in your picks. Visit the pool page at http://www.themall.net/~hwci/ncaa to download the software and for complete instructions.
2) Get a copy of the brackets from a newspaper or wherever you can find it, fill out the winners, type out your selections and, send them to us via e-mail. For tie-breaker purposes, you will also need to send us a prediction for the total score in the final game. For instance, if you think the score will be 75-71, you would send in a score of 146. Also, for amusement purposes, you need to send us a nickname by which you will be represented in the standings. For instance, the last two years I have gone by the handle "The Mighty Mobelfakta", and I will again be assuming that identity this year, so that name's taken, think of another one. This is the probably the most efficient way of sending your picks:

Also, as soon as all the picks are in, we will send out a listing of everybody's picks, so that you know we're on the level. ## 3/13/97, Issue \# 3.1.1 "Let the games begin..."

Fourteen of the top seeds won their games providing defending HWCI NCAA Pool Champ JAYBIAN II and DUKE with a record 15-1 Thursday, good for 30 points and the lead. One of the top seeds that lost was \#8 Indiana to \#9 Colorado, hardly an upset. The other game even most experts predicted would happen, with \#12 College of Charleston getting their 23rd consecutive win... and some respect, knocking off \#5 Maryland. Just five of the 22 entrants went Charleston's way. UCLA didn't disappoint anyone this time, eclipsing last year's 41 point total (vs Princeton) in the first 16 minutes and providing the most convincing win of the day over \#15 Charleston Southern, 109-75. Two \#1 teams struggled, with North Carolina winning by just eight points over Fairfield (11-19) and Kansas by just 14 over Jackson St (14-16). The other \#1 seed in action today, Kentucky, routed Montana. \#12 Princeton almost upset another Pac-10 team, falling just short of Cal, 55-52. \#4 Villanova outran Long Island U (LIU), 101-91.
\#8 Purdue rallied to win on overtime, giving seven people with a perfect 8-0 in the first half of the day, with all the top seeds winning. At the end of the day, ten players are tied for 6th with 26 points.
KARL CHILDERS starts off the slowest, with just 20 points.

## 3/15/97, Issue \# 5.2.1 "The Return of the Jaybian"

Defending HWCI NCAA Tournament Pool Champion JAYBIAN II reeled off an HWCI record-tying perfect 80 Saturday to vault into a six point lead with 74 points. No one else had more than six correct. Both BAD ASS I and DUKE fell from first to a tie for fourth with 68 points. \#1 North Carolina got its coach Dean Smith his NCAA record 877th win to start off the day. \#1 Kansas and \#1 Kentucky both had to battle midway in the second half before advancing to the Sweet Sixteen. The biggest upset was \#6 Iowa State taking care of \#3 Cincy, where six entrants had them in their Final Four (besides JAYBIAN II, only SHARKBABY pegged this one). \#2 UCLA put on another offensive showing in its win over \#7 Xavier. BUCKEYE MIKE was the only one not to pick UCLA into the third round. Despite not making crucial free throws, \#4 St. Joeseph won in overtime over \#5 BC. \#12 College of Charleston's 23-game win streak ended, but not without a fight, nearly coming back from seven points down in the last minute against \#4 Arizona. Only three people (JAYBIAN II, TODD SMITH, and DUKE FAN) foresaw \#5 Cal making it to the Sweet Sixteen.

Tomorrow will finally show who is still in the running for the top three spots. THE FABONE ( 54 pts ) and KARL CHILDERS (52) are at the bottom, but we won't know if they're eliminated until after tomorrow's games. For a little history, both Mark (now dubbed SHARKBABY) and Brian (now as THE FLYING ELVI) have ended the past two HWCI NCAA Pools with the exact number of points. So guess what? They are tied for second with 68 points. They were also tied after the first round. No one has an intact Elite Eight left and so far, seven have had all their Final Four teams winning today.

## 3/16/97, Issue \# 6.2.2 "The little Chattanooga that could"

The Sweet Sixteen will feature a \#14 seed, two \#10 seeds, and three \#6 seeds causing only BAD ASS I, RODERICK, and MAX to achieve a 4-4 record on Sunday. All of the above seeds won on Sunday except \#6 Iowa St. Only \#10 Texas was seeded higher than its opponent, \#15 Coppin St. (in Baltimore, FYI), which showed a lot of heart and nearly upset Texas. The inexperience of Coppin St. both helped and hindered them. An unnecessary three-point attempt actually went in to close the gap to one, then they rushed a shot to try go ahead in the final seconds, but it was blocked. The subsequent inbound pass was stolen and time ran out. Only KDOGG and BAD ASS I picked Texas to reach the Sweet Sixteen. Coppin State almost became the first \#15 seed to make it past the second round.
\#1 Minnesota quieted critics momentarily by breezing past Temple. \#3 New Mexico fell, partially due to two quick and dumb fouls by NM's Kenny Thomas, who fouled out. He left with the stupidest grin (as if saying "Did I do that?") and \#6 Louisville held on to win. \#2 Duke became the second two-seed to not reach the third round. TODD SMITH (now known as FRODO) did not pick Duke to make it, but he thought Marquette would do the job, not \#10 Providence. \#14 Tennessee-Chattanooga becomes this year's Cinderella team knocking out \#6 Illinois. \#6 Stanford became the fourth Pac-10 team to make the Sweet Sixteen (again, only FRODO picked Stanford), upsetting \#3 Wake Forest. \#4 Clemson and \#2 Utah added some stability amongst all the upsets.

As for the pool, JAYBIAN II went just 3-5 for the day but ended up with a high of 11 correct in Round 2 to keep the lead with 83 points, four more than BAD ASS I. Nine are within ten points of the leader. BAD ASS II is also close-by tied for fourth. THE FLYING ELVI is third with 77 points and separated from SHARKBABY, who fell hard from second to seventh and can't finish higher than third. LOCBOY and THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA can't win the big prize of $\$ 125$. THE FABONE and COWGIRL IN LOVE, tied for 20th in points with 63, can still finish first, albeit unlikely. RHODES, EZRA, and BUCKEYE MIKE all have more points than these two but are eliminated from the prize money. Last place KARL CHILDERS is also eliminated with a record-low 58 points after two rounds. All four eliminated have Kansas as their top pick.

UPDATES: DUKE FAN's picks have been finally cleared up, after the transfer from Mac to PC produced different results. Amazingly, nothing changes. His score is the same. The four eliminated are still so. If you are keeping track, however, note his different Elite 8 and Final Four picks... TODD SMITH has chosen the nickname "FRODO"... DUKE FAN will remain "DUKE FAN"--- not to be confused with just "DUKE", Dennis' entry... Dennis has chosen "174" to be his magic number in case of a tie for both of his entries.

Four teams had double-digit leads in the second half and three went into overtime. Of the three, two still held on to win. But it took overtime pay of one Dollar to accomplish a successful comeback of 16 points by UCLA.

Cameron Dollar went coast-to-coast, a la Tyus Edney in 1995, to put \#2 UCLA into the Elite Eight and cap off a wild day. An amazing sequence of events capped of the overtime game: \# 6 Iowa State misses a shot and UCLA rebounds- but two hold on to the ball and the ref calls traveling; the inbound play is an alley-oop and Iowa St. leads by one; the quick inbound is taken by Dollar who goes the distance, throws a high bank off the glass to put UCLA up by one with 1.9 seconds left; Iowa St. forgets to count to five and doesn't inbound the ball in time (actually, the time out was called too late) giving UCLA back the ball; then UCLA almost repeats Iowa St.'s mistake, barely inbounding the ball in time to run out the clock.

The other game in the Midwest Regional also went to double overtime with \#1 Minnesota barely overcoming a gutsy \#4 Clemson team. \#2 Utah blew a lead but went on to beat \#6 Stanford, also in overtime. You might have thought Princeton was playing, as the score was just 6-2 Utah 9:30 into
the game. In fact, the game was totally ugly at the beginning. It seemed like the rim was smaller or something. Utah's win combined with Clemson's loss eliminated SHARKBABY, THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA, and LOCBOY. Also, THE FABONE and DUKE FAN were denied a chance of first place.
\#1 Kentucky took care of \#4 St. Joseph's easily. This bumbled DUKE FAN a notch down to no better than third. \#4 Arizona shocked the number one team in the country, \#1 Kansas (34-2), 85-82, to advance to the Elite Eight. Kansas, the first \#1 seed to fall in the tourney, rallied from 13 points down with 3:29 left to within one, (83-82) but three 3-pt attempts fell short on their last possession. Only FRODO had Arizona beating Kansas and his foresight eliminated BAD ASS I from money contention, even though he is tied for third in points with 91. FORDO also has Arizona going to the Final Four, an almost sure bet now that they get to play \#10 Providence. Providence beat \#14 Tenn-Chat, but couldn't make free throws and allowed Tenn-Chat to almost catch up in the last minute.
\#1 North Carolina rallied in the second half to put away \#5 Cal. All 22 entries had UNC in the Elite Eight. UNC plays \#6 Louisville on Saturday, who beat \#10 Texas. If it weren't for all the upsets in the tourney, it would look like a sure bet that UNC and Arizona would meet in the Final Four. BUCKEYE MIKE is last with 72 points and is in danger of setting a new all-time low for points. His BEST would tie the lowest point total (80) if UNC beats Louisville on Sunday. JAYBIAN II still leads with 99 points, the first time the leader after Round 3 was held to under 100 points.

Most surprisingly, Arizona was able to rebound with Kansas, as only Paul Pierce seemed to be an advantage for Kansas. The game didn't end without a run by Kansas, however. Down by ten with less than 2 minutes remaining, Kansas began a three-point barrage that eventually cut the lead to one. But Arizona made its free throws and Kansas' last second three-point attempts didn't fall. Arizona's win made the Pac-10 the only conference to put 2 teams in the Great Eight. How big an upset was this? 12 out of 22 entrants had Kansas winning it all. 16 had them reaching the final game. 21 had them making the Final Four. Only FRODO correctly picked Arizona in the upset. FRODO rode the Pac-10 wave into third place, behind Jaybian II and Bix Pix. In the other late game, it at first seemed that Cal was poised to repeat what Arizona had done earlier. They held an 8 point lead well into the second half, before succumbing to North Carolina. Antwan Jamison was huge for North Carolina in its second half run. In the earlier East Regional semi-final, Louisville ran away from Texas, despite the absence of star guard Dejuan Wheat for the final 10 minutes of the game. And finally, Providence ended Tennessee-Chattanooga's Cinderella tournament run.

BADASS I was the only entrant eliminated from prize money contention today. Because of Kansas' lost, JAYBIAN II's hold on first is all the more precarious, as he only has two of his final four left. FRODO is the only player left with his entire final four intact.

Also a note: the HWCI Tournament Pool Page at http://www.themall.net/~hwci/ has been updated to include a listing of all the 128 possible scenarios that can occur from here on out. Next to each scenario, are the corresponding prize money winners. So, if you want to see how you might do for any given scenario, you know where to go.

## 3/22/97, Issue \# 9.4.1 "Minnesota is for real"

\#2 UCLA ran out of gas in the second half, allowing \#1 Minnesota to become the first team to advance to the Final Four in Indianapolis. \#1 Kentucky and \#2 Utah battled for about thirty-five minutes before Kentucky pulled away in convincing fashion.

LENNY and THE FABONE were eliminated from money contention with Minnesota's win. MAX, RODERICK, and THE FLYING ELVI were the only ones to have Minnesota in the Final Four. JAYBIAN II still holds onto the lead and has 16 chances (out of 32 ) to win, but his lead has been diminishing and he only has Kentucky left in his Final Four. Last year, he won with just Kentucky in his Final Four, but this year may prove to be different. MAX has moved into second with 102 points. THE FLYING ELVI and BIX PIX are tied for third with 101 points, but won't be able to grab first place. The amazing FRODO, who picked Arizona over Kansas, lost the chance to become the first person to correctly pick all four teams in the Final Four (53 entries in three years). BAD ASS II went $0-2$ but still has a chance for second or third (only if UNC beats Minnesota in the Final), with 87 points. COWGIRL IN LOVE and DUKE FAN were eliminated and BAD ASS II was eliminated from first when Kentucky won.

This year will be the third straight year no one has pegged the Final Four (53 entries), thanks to UCLA's loss breaking up FRODO's Final Four. The new HWCI NCAA Pool Champion will win with the lowest point total in history. HENG, currently in 10th with 90 points, has the highest "possible points" with 124 (BIX PIX won in 1995 with 148 points and JAYBIAN won last year with 144 points). Fifteen of the previous 31 entries in the past two years have had more than 124 points. KARL CHILDERS, who was last after each of the first two rounds, stormed back with a 5-3 record in Round 3 (tying MAX and BIX PIX for the high) to go from 22nd to 17th, but now will be forever stuck with 84 points, becoming the first person this year to mispick all four Final Four teams. But he won't finish last, as BUCKEYE MIKE is almost certain to occupy the basement with 74 points (max possible of 80).

Four people went 0-2 and have a chance to join three others in history to go 0-7 in the last three rounds and earn the "Kind-of-Brian Clause (tm) Award" worth \$0.00.

Like \#1 Kentucky, \#1 North Carolina blew a lead in the second half but came back with vengeance and stormed past \#6 Louisville and into the Final Four for the 13th time. UNC's victory eliminated defending champ JAYBIAN II from the top spot of this year's tourney, paving the way for a new HWCI NCAA Pool Champion. JAYBIAN II still has a chance for third place. MAX has rallied from 16 points down after 40 games and nine points down after three rounds to take the lead with 108 points. RODERICK and DUKE were eliminated. Despite Alvin's BAD ASS I having ten more points than BAD ASS II, it's BAD ASS II which still has a chance for second place. UNC's win assured no one would win the "Kind-of-Brian-Clause ${ }^{t \mathrm{tm}}$ by having no wins in the last three rounds.
\#4 Arizona suffered another last minute collapse- this time a 10-pt lead with 3:30 left- and pulled out the victory once again. \#10 Providence, playing with pure heart, climbed back the hard way with the benefit of only one 3-pointer to tie the game. Arizona played very sloppy and took quick unnecessary shots to give Providence hope. Providence surprisingly made the free throws that counted- making the first and missing the second allowing for a rebound opportunity. After Providence tied the score, Arizona hurried back down only to turn the ball over but Providence failed to capitalize. Providence simply ran out of gas in the overtime. They battled with what they had, but Arizona nearly made every shot... and still Providence nearly tied the game again. Clearly, Arizona has the better chance of beating UNC in the semifinal, but the mistakes Arizona made were mistakes I've only seen in the ABL (women's league). Costly turnovers, not running out the clock... you would think Arizona would learn from Kansas's attempted comeback the last game.

BAD ASS II and BIX PIX now only have a chance for third place. MAX wins money on all possibilities EXCEPT if UNC beat Minnesota in the Final. The three people who picked 3 out of the 4 Final Four teams are at the top of the standings. FRODO (1st, 109 pts), MAX (2nd, 108), and HENG (6th, 96) are the only three people who still have a chance at the First Place Prize of $\$ 125$. BIX PIX not only needs Minnesota in the Final (Gophers beating UNC, or facing Arizona), but needs to also win the tiebreaker if he wants third place. In a game that meant nothing... well, to this pool at least, both Wildcat teams fought it out to the very end. Once again, Arizona blew a lead late in the second half, but wound up winning it in overtime (thanks to the courtesy line), 84-79, over Kentucky. This was the first time a team beat three \#1 seeds (Kansas-SE, UNC-E, Kentucky-W). If Arizona got their paws on \#1MW-Minnesota (beaten by Kentucky in the semifinals), they probably would've beaten them, too- but alas, the most you can face are three \#1 seeds. Miles Simon ( 30 points) along with the refs (who sent Arizona to the line 41 times) led the Arizona Wildcats (25-9) to their first national title in basketball. Sophomore Ron Mercer of Kentucky did not have a great game and fouled out in his last college game. FYI, the other Wildcat vs Wildcat final was in 1951 when Kentucky beat the Kansas State Wildcats. Kentucky (35-5) failed to repeat as champions, though many did not even expect them to go this far. A Pac-10 team has now won two of the past three titles (UCLA 1995).

## 4/1/97, Issue \# 15.6.3 "\$20 gets you nothin'"

WRAPUP- Three people decided to test out the $\$ 20$ idea by submitting two entries- and all three wound up with nothing in return. Maybe $\$ 10$ is a good idea after all... Jason Selander had the most wins (out of 63) for the second year in a row, netting him $\$ 145$ in two years and making him the only two-time money winner... Alvin keeps getting close, but no cigar- he finished 5th in 1995, 7th in 1996 and 4th this year... Mike went from 4th last year to last (22nd) this year... Scott HW went from $4^{\text {th }}(1995)$ and $6^{\text {th }}$ (1996) to 13th this year- had Kentucky won in regulation (keeping total points less than 146, he would've finished fourth again)... There have been no changes in points (2/3/4/6/8/12 system) or the entry fee (\$10) for all three pools, keeping everything consistent and comparable... Although we would like to keep a status quo, we are looking for ideas to improve the systemit ain't our fault no one picked Arizona to win it all!... Some ideas include:
[1] If 30 or more entries next year, including a fourth place money winner (in keeping with the Final Four theme);
[2] raising the entry fee, although I read in the paper most pools run from $\$ 1$ to $\$ 10$, so I guess we are in the Upper Class of Tournament Pools;
[3] reducing first round points to one per win instead of two, but multiplying it by the seed that wins (i.e., points from 1 for a $\# 1$ seed winning to 16 for a 16th-seeded team winning) and ONLY using this method in the first round and keeping the rest of the point system. For this year, MAX would finish fifth, BAD ASS I first, FRODO second, and the FLYING ELVI and JAYBIAN II would be bumped one spot to third and fourth, respectively. COWGIRL IN LOVE, BUCKEYE MIKE, and KARL CHILDERS still finish in the bottom three. Although this is my idea, I don't like it, but it is something to think about; and
[4] Investing some of the pool money next year (or over several years) for a registered NCAA Pool program.

I'm only in favor of [1] and possibly [4], if we get a lot of entries. Really, the only change in the three years has been the addition of the "total points tie-breaker" system in 1996. It's been a very good system developed by the boys of HW-UCLA. If we do get a lot of participants, I'm in favor of diverting some of the money to other categories- such as most points in first round via points by seeding or a bonus for getting all Final Four picks in (money could roll over to next year if no one gets it).

Here is the updated list of career leaders. This is the third straight year the winner's points and average points has declined- suggesting either more upsets are winning or we are picking worse. Over three years, the bottom line is that Alvin is out $\$ 40$ while Jason is up $\$ 125$.

## 1997 National Championship Recap

They were two separate beasts, one the reigning king of college basketball, the other poised to stake its claim. The Wildcats of Kentucky, seeking to repeat as national champions, were being challenged by the western species of Wildcat, the University of Arizona. What eventually evolved was one of the most scintillating and sizzling championship games of the 1990s, as Arizona became the first team in NCAA championship history to defeat three No. 1 seeds (Kansas, North Carolina and Kentucky) on its way to the title.

Led by junior Miles Simon, Arizona took on a Kentucky program that, despite its No. 1 seeding, played above expectations all season after losing star Derek Anderson to a knee injury in mid-season. Arizona, on the other hand, was the championship's hottest team.

With Arizona's quickness and fast break tempo facing Kentucky's full-court press, the pulse of the game started at a rapid pace and did not let up until Arizona pulled the upset and won its first national championship, 84-79, in overtime. Simon, the Final Four most outstanding player, led all scorers with 30 points and hit every big shot for the Wildcats.
