## Who's eligible to join the pool?

Anyone and everyone (members of participating NCAA programs might want to consider carefully, though ;)).

## What are the requirements?

The only requirements are that the $\$ 10$ entry fee is paid before the round of 16 games have begun, and that the pertinent entry information is received before the start of the tournament. The pertinent entry information would include:

- Real name
- Preferred nickname (I am the Mighty Mobelfakta, so that name's taken already).
- Prediction for the total combined score of the championship game (for tie-breaking purposes).
- Predicted winners of all 63 tournament games.

How are the points scored?
2 points for each 1st round win
3 points for each 2nd round win
4 points for each 3rd round win
6 points for each 4th round win
8 points for each 5th round win
12 points for correctly picking the NCAA Champion
There is no weighting for "upsets".
How is the prize money distributed?
Last year, with 22 entries, there was a first, second, and third place prize. The $\$ 220.00$ pot was split accordingly: 1 st- $\$ 125.00$, 2nd- $\$ 60.00$, and 3rd- $\$ 35.00$. This year the money will be split with roughly the same proportions going to the winners. If participation increases from last year, we will reward prize money for the top four finishers (in the spirit of the Final Four).

## What if there's a tie?

The participant whose prediction comes closest (higher or lower) for the final combined score of the championship game will win the tie-breaker. If there is STILL a tie, the money will be split. For instance, if there is a tie for first place, the winners will split the combined prize money for first and second place. FYI, in three years of running this pool, we have yet to have a tie.

## Can I enter more than once?

You certainly can. Statistically, your chances of winning would double. However, so far of the four people (eight entries) that have tried their luck with two entries, none have taken home any prize money. Go figure.

1. Get thee a copy of the NCAA Men's Tournament Bracket. The most convenient place to get one would be the sports section of your local newspaper. You can also get the brackets at the following websites:
http://espnet.sportszone.com/ncb/ncaatourney98/ncbprintbracket.html http://www.sportsline.com/u/madness/1998/brackets/printable_men.htm and locally right here.
2. Fill out the brackets completely using all the college basketball wisdom you can conjure up.
3. Make a prediction for the total combined score for the championship game. For instance, if you think the final score will be 82-76, your prediction would be 158 .
4. Create a nickname for yourself. This is important, because if you don't give us one, we'll make one up for you. Historically, these assigned nicknames have not been flattering.
5. Send all that precious information this-away before the first game on Thursday, March 12. Obviously, the fastest way to get the info here is by e-mail (dfeng@jps.net and webmaster@cobaltcorp.com).

The pool is open to all who are interested，so feel free to forward this e－mail to others．The entry fee is $\$ 10$ ，and the picks are due next Thursday，March 12．The entry payment deadline is flexible．Basically，if you were invited to join，we know you＇re good for the 10 bucks，so don＇t sweat it．The scoring is weighted by round and not by seeds，so picking underdogs correctly will give you the same amount of points as picking the favorite correctly．Of course，by picking a low seed victory correctly， you will be getting points that most entrants won＇t，so it still may be worth it．The point distribution is as follows：

2 points for each 1st round win
3 points for each 2nd round win
4 points for each 3rd round win 6 points for each 4th round win 8 points for each 5th round win 12 points for picking the NCAA Champion

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Believe it or not，\＃11E Washington will play \＃14E Richmond for a chance to advance to the Sweet Sixteen．It was that kind of day．Those who thought that \＃3E had an easy path into the Sweet 16 when \＃6E Xavier was eliminated by Washington were soon in shock two hours later when Richmond shocked South Carolina．Then again，it might not have been THAT surprising－SC was seeded \＃2 last year and lost in the first round，and Richmond is one of only 3 teams to have ever beaten a \＃2 seed（since the tourney expanded to 64 teams）．Throw in \＃10W West Virginia and you had yourselves quite an upset Thursday．It could have been worse as \＃2E UConn held off \＃15E FDU，\＃2W Cincy barely got by \＃15W Northern Arizona，and \＃7E Indiana needed OT after blowing a 19－point lead（OK decided to watch the overtime session instead of playing in it－ no wanted to shoot the ball，then they intentionally foul after wasting
25 seconds off the shot clock（this was the first game I saw，with work making me miss the morning／afternoon games）to get past \＃10E OK．
The top seeds Arizona（West）and UNC（East）had no trouble at all． With Xavier and South Carolina out of the way，UConn seems to have an easy path into the Big 8 ．Disciplined \＃5E Princeton held off the \＃12E Runnin＇Rebels of UNLV while 2 of 3 Illini teams（\＃9W Illinois St．in a thriller in OT and \＃5W Illinois）advanced（only \＃9E Illinois－ Chicago spoiling the fun）．UNC will face \＃8E UNC－Charlotte in the 2nd round．\＃4E Michigan St．showed \＃13E Eastern Michigan that the past is past with a convincing victory．

The pool？Oh，yeah．An HWCI－record 28 people（final tally，if any snail mailed entries arrive，will be on Sunday）have entered the 4th Annual HWCI NCAA Pool．Only 3 wins separate 1st from last，with four tied on top with 13 wins（ 26 points）．Sixteen picked UNC to win it all，with Arizona

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At least the \＃1 seeds are having an easy time．Five more double－digit seeds made it to the second round，joining the three who made it yesterday． And \＃12S Iona nearly had \＃5S Syracuse pegged if it weren＇t for a last－second three－pointer．\＃12MW Florida St．silenced critics who thought they shouldn＇t have made it to the tournament by upsetting \＃5MW Texas Christian and will play \＃13MW Valparaiso sneaked in on an incredible buzzer－beating three－pointer．All the upsets except for \＃10MW Detroit＇s win over \＃7MW St．John＇s occurred in the afternoon sessions（first 8 games）．\＃6S UCLA＇s Henderson made his free－throws when it ultimately counted－in the final seconds，as they just slipped by \＃11S Miami．With \＃2MW Purdue routing \＃15MW Deleware，the Big 10 Conference has gone 5－0 in the tourney．UCLA＇s win pushed the Pac－10 to 4－0．

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I went to the US soccer game in San Diego and went to eat lunch at Qualcomm Stadium. The TV was on so I decided to see how \#1E North Carolina, the team I picked to go all the way, was doing. Up by six points, I see... pretty close. Wait.. what? Overtime??? My heart sunk and was glad I didn't have to see \#8 UNC-Charlotte tie it up to send it to overtime. Luckily, UNC-C played like OK did in overtime against Indiana... basically watched it and got beat badly in OT. But, we still got to see an upset (although probably not unexpected) in the hellish afternoon sessions with \#2W Cincy falling in the last second to \#10W West Virginia, who had earlier upset \#7W Temple. The battle of the double-digit seeds saw \#11 Washington upend \#14 Richmond. \#3W Utah, \#2E UConn (I am probably only saying UConn cause I'm too lazy to look up the spelling of that state...), and \#4W Maryland struggled before pulling away to wins in the final minutes. \#4E Michigan St. put away \#5E Princeton, who suffered only their second loss of the season, to get into the Sweet 16. Top West seed Arizona's rout improved the Pac-10's record to 6-0 in the tournament, with Stanford and UCLA playing tomorrow.

Who's heading closer to a money prize? MONEY, of course. He picked 7 of 8 games correctly to move into first place ( 67 points), thanks to a gutsy pick of having Washington in the Sweet 16. His only loss was Cincy's, which everyone missed except ANNA COME LATELY (2nd, 66 pts), who really did pick West Virginia. However, in 1995, LOSER WHO DIDN'T

PICK UCLA went from 9th to 1st after picking 14 of 16 2nd Round games correctly, and ended up in last after the Championship Game. Appropriately enough, the two players tied for last ( 50 pts ) are named CALAMITY and (PREKI THE) BOMB. But the player who could be in worse shape is BAERSARKE (16th, 58 pts) who trails only by 9 points ( 5 from 4th place) but is the only person to have not one, but both of his Championship Final teams out of the tourney (Mississippi and Arkansas). We'll see after tomorrow's games if any of these three still has a chance at one of the prize positions.

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## VALPARAISO MAKES IT TO THE SWEET 16 WHILE \#1 KANSAS GOES HOME EARLY AGAIN

Only 10 people remain in contention for the top prize of $\mathbf{\$ 1 5 0}$

Like last year, \#1MW (also \#1 in the country at the time of the last poll) Kansas spoiled the chance of the first time in NCAA history (64-team field) all four \#1 seeds advanced to the Final Four. Last year, Arizona knocked off \#1SE Kansas in the Sweet 16 while all three of the other \#1 seeds made it to the Final Four. This could have been the year all four seeds succeeded but while the other 3 seeds are progressing as normal, Kansas will once again go home early. \#8MW Rhode Island, led by ex-UCLA coach Jim Harrick, stunned Kansas and will face another Cinderella team, \#13MW Valparaiso (whose assistant coach is Harrick's son) who beat \#12MW Florida St. in overtime. \#2 Purdue and \#3 Stanford will face each other in the other Midwest regional semifinal.
\#5S Syracuse beat \#4S New Mexico (the only game I've seen this year, and it was just the ending, involved NM and UNLV in the conference final, and NM tanked it) got beat by \#4 New Mexico and will face \#1S Duke. \#6S UCLA outplayed \#3S Michigan and will face \#2S Kentucky.

Like a good basketball game, ANNA COME LATELY regained the lead from MONEY to lead the pool for the second consecutive round.

Her 84 points is just two more than MONEY who suffered a couple of hits for the first time with 2 of his Elite 8 teams out. BAERSARKE (18th) may have picked Kansas to do the poorest (losing in Sweet 16), but his possible score of just 92 is the lowest-ever after 2 rounds, with four of his Elite 8 teams out of the tourney. He joins three others (ALL 2 EASY (who was tied for first after Round 1), CALAMITY, and PREKI THE BOMB) out of the running for any of the money spots. PIPI GIRL would also be out of contention if it weren't for the new 4th place prize. Thirteen others won't get the top prize this year. Even BUCKEYE MIKE, who is tied for 23rd place, can still claim the top prize.

No one picked Rhode Island or Valparaiso (obviously) to win (marking the first time no one picked a game correctly) while only 8 had faith in our hometown UCLA team. Speaking of UCLA, and on a side note, there was an interesting finish in Women's tournament action as the UCLA women's team lost apparently on a timekeeper's error. I was listening on the way home for about $1 / 2$ hour as they tried to get the officials to look at the tape. Haven't heard any decision on the outcome, yet.

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## THREE＇S THE CHARM AS UCONN ADVANCES TO THE ELITE EIGHT <br> Pool field narrows as six more players are eliminated from money spots

It took three shots，but \＃2E UConn finally made the game－winning basket in the final ten seconds as \＃11E Washington failed to clear the ball several times．The last second flurry at the end sent UConn to the Elite 8 and sent the Pac－10 Conference with its first loss of the tournament（9－1）． UConn will play \＃1E North Carolina who beat \＃4E Michigan St．in its home state．\＃3W Utah held off a late rally by \＃10W West Virginia to advance to play defending NCAA Champion \＃1W Arizona who ran away with \＃4 Maryland（This was one of the tougher late games for me to pick．．． Maryland or Arizona．．．I originally had Maryland（its comparisions to the 97 Arizona team），but cooler minds prevailed，thankfully）．

No upsets here as both \＃1 seeds and one \＃2 seed advanced as usual to the Elite 8．\＃3W Utah＇s path was cleared when \＃2W Cincinnati fell in the 2 nd round．In fact 27 of 28 had UNC in the regional final， 26 picked Arizona， 20 picked UConn，and 11 picked Utah．Seven bettors went 4－0 helping push five more players out of money contention （KADIAN，THE FLYING ELVI，SHAKERMAKER，FOOT DOCTOR，SLAVE TO BIG SIX）． That makes 3 of the 4 ＂Kim＂s out of contention（Edmund，Alvin，Daniel
with Dennis finishing no higher than 3rd). PIPI GIRL and JOON can't finish higher than 4th while eight still remain for the top prize (with yours truly not part of this exclusive group :-(). MONEY (1st, 98 points) regained the lead once again from ANNA COMES LATELY (2nd, 96) as we head into the final 11 games of the tournament. Will ANNA regain the lead like she has in the past two rounds? BAERSARKE (26th, 74 ) is coming dangerously close to setting the all-time record for least number of points (80) as he only has 14 more points to gain. PREKI THE BOMB continues his stay in last with 67 points, but can still top the 100-point barrier (105 possible). ANNA has the 2nd-most longshot championship game matchup of this year's pool with a \#3W Utah-\#6S UCLA game (BAERSARKE has the longest longshot: \#4MW Mississippi and \#6W Arkansas, both eliminated within the first 2 rounds), yet somehow, both teams are still alive. BUCKEYE MIKE sits tied for 13th (84) with a shot at first place while 5th-place THE FABONE (92) can't finish higher than second place.

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## UCLA GETS WHIPPED WHILE RHODE ISLAND FINDS ITS WAY INTO ELITE 8 How the mighty fall- Anna Comes Lately drops to 6th; Money out of 1st

\#2S Kentucky continues its surge, routing \#6S UCLA in advancing to
Sunday's showdown with \#1S Duke, who took care of \#5S Syracuse. This game will spark memories of the 1992 showdown where Duke won 104-103 on a hail mary pass in overtime to beat Kentucky.
Meanwhile, \#3MW Stanford held off \#2MW Purdue and the Battle of the Cinderellas was won by \#8MW Rhode Island (headed by ex-UCLA coach Jim Harrick) who knocked off \#13MW Valparaiso (whose assistant coach is Harrick's son).

Meanwhile in the pool, ANNA COMES LATELY did not regain the top spot from MONEY as she had the previous two rounds. In fact, ANNA went only 4 for 8 in the 3rd round to fall to 6th place while MONEY picked only 5 of 8 to get knocked out of the top prize position. Only five players remain for the $\$ 150$ first place prize: CAVEMAN (1st, 107 pts), ANNA (6th, 100), BIX'S PIX'S (7th, 99), SCOTTMAN (unfortunately, not me) (tied 9th, 96), and BUCKEYE MIKE (who was dead last in 1997 with a record-low of 80 points) (tied 9th, 96). CAVEMAN vaulted into first picking 7 of 8 games correctly. THE FABONE (104 pts) (silently) has moved into 2nd, the highest he will ever hope to get. Because 16 people picked North Carolina to win it all, those who didn't are in a better position.

\#3W Utah never let defending NCAA champion \#1W Arizona in the game as they roared into the Final Four. Andre Miller had a triple-double, 18 pts-14 rbs-13 asts to lead the Utes. Utah will play \#1E North Carolina, who beat \#2E UConn. Arizona became the 2nd \#1 seed to not make the Final Four (following \#1MW Kansas) in the year most people thought this would be the tourney where all four \#1 seeds made it to the Final Four.

## RHODE ISLAND BLOWS A 7-POINT LEAD IN SECONDS; KENTUCKY RALLIES FROM 17 DOWN

## If Utah beats UNC, Anna Come Lately claims $\mathbf{\$ 1 5 0}$ prize, otherwise Caveman

It a heart-breaker, \#8MW Rhode Island blew a 7-point lead in the final minutes as \#3MW Stanford advanced to the Final Four. URI's inexperience showed with silly fouls stopping the clock and missed free throws (including all 3 attempts in the final seconds) allowed Stanford to take control of the game. Meanwhile, \#1S Duke saw its 17-point lead with about 10 minutes left evaporate as \#2S Kentucky continued its hot tear into the Final Four game vs Stanford. Duke did have a chance to try to rekindle the 1992 game when Kentucky (at the time, stupidly) called a timeout when Duke had none with four seconds left. But it was not to be as the desperation 3-pt attempt was too high and Duke lost its first Regional Final game ever (7-1). Duke's loss meant \#1E North Carolina was the only \#1 seed to advance to the Final Four.

I had to root for KY even though I had Duke picked because my chances to finish either 2nd or 3rd was better. I also wanted to URI to win but they just couldn't hold it together. Rather sad. So I thought KY was going under trailing by 17, but KY fought back and could hit the three-point
shots. With KY's win, that means that CAVEMAN
will finish 1st if UNC beats Utah in the semifinals and ANNA COME LATELY
will finish 1st if UNC loses to Utah. After four long years, I will
finally taste some sort of victory, either finishing 2nd, tied for 2nd, or 3rd. A total of 7 players are fighting for the final positions with MONEY, POINT MAN, SCOTTMAN, and BUCKEYE MIKE tied for fourth with 108 points, behind ANNA (1st, 118), CAVEMAN (2nd, 113), and THE FABONE (3rd, 110). POINT MAN, SCOTTMAN, and BUCKEYE MIKE can't finish higher than 4th, while MONEY can't finish higher than 3rd. Although first place will be decided by the Final game, 2nd-4th are still up for grabs when the Championship game is played on Monday, March 29.

UTHPOPE went $0-4$ while ANNA went $3-1$ for Round 4.18 players went $0-2$ today and only 2 picked Stanford correctly and 8 picked Kentucky.

It will all come down next weekend when the final placements in the pool will be decided．The main semifinal game of interest will be the \＃1E UNC－\＃3W Utah game．If UNC wins，then CAVEMAN finishes first and SCOTMAN and BUCKEYE MIKE go home empty．If Utah wins，ANNA COME LATELY gets 1st，CAVEMAN 2nd，THE FABONE（yours truly）3rd，with a 4－way tie for 4th place．Also，the dubious distinction of finishing in last place will also be decided with the UNC－Utah game．If UNC wins， BAERSARKE will finish 28th with 84 points．If Utah wins，SLAVE TO BIG SIX will end this nightmare dead last with just 83 points（previous last－place finishers：LOSER WHO DIDN＇T PICK UCLA（98 points in 1995）， THE CHEF（80 in 1996），and BUCKEYE MIKE（80 in 1997））．

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## HWCI＇S 2ND SPORT POOL WILL FEATURE THE 1998 WORLD CUP SOCCER TOURNAMENT <br> Contestants will pick 48 individual games before the Round of 16 begins

The HWCI NCAA Pool has been a tremendous success with particpation increasing every year（from 12 in 1995 to 28 in 1998）．I never thought I＇d be plunking ten bucks to play in a pool of a sport I really never watched（college basketball，that is）．With the World Cup expanding to 32 teams，the format is more pool－friendly than before．Therefore， Fernando and I will start the HWCI WC98 Pool in the footsteps of the successful HWCI NCAA one．

Because there is less than 24 hours from the end of the Round Robin and the start of the Round of 16 ，there isn＇t a way to get out the Round of 16 bracket in time for picking．Therefore，you will have to pick your own Round of 16 teams．You could conceivably pick two teams that will advance to the next round who play EACH OTHER．Therefore，there is an advantage to picking the teams in the right order（i．e．，first－place and second－place team）in your mind．A bracket will be provided later so you can see how the teams will advance．

The format（though not set in stone）will be as follows：
1．Each person will pick all 48 first－round round－robin matches （schedule is already posted at www．fifa．com）．
2. No matter how you picked the 1st Round matches, you will pick the top 2 teams in each of the eight (8) groups (Group A, B, C $\mathrm{D}, \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{F}, \mathrm{G}$, and H ). These teams will advance to the Round of 16 . (The WC98 format will label these teams 1A, 2A, 1B, 2B, etc...)
3. The WC98 format will have 1 A vs $2 \mathrm{~B}, 2 \mathrm{~A}$ vs $1 \mathrm{~B}, 1 \mathrm{C}$ vs $2 \mathrm{D}, 2 \mathrm{C}$ vs 1 D , etc. You will pick the two teams you think will advance from
Groups A-B (i.e., from A1,A2,B1,B2), Groups C-D, Groups E-F, and Groups G-H (for a total of 8 teams). These teams will advance to the quarterfinals.
4. Of the four teams in Groups A/B/C/D, you will pick two. Of the four teams in Groups E/F/G/H, you will pick two.
The four teams you pick will advance to the semifinals.
5. You will pick the two winners from the four teams to advance to the Final Match.
6. You will pick the World Cup 1998 Champion.

## 7. TIEBREAKER:

a. Total goals scored in the 3rd Place and Final Matches (2 matches). You will be able to pick in $1 / 2$ goals (e.g., $0,1 / 2,1,11 / 2,2,21 / 2$, etc.) since there are not as many goals scored. The past two World Cups have both yielded 4 goals. Usually, the 3rd Place match is high-scoring while the Final Match is low-scoring. Whoever gets closest to the total wins the tiebreaker.
b. You will also pick who you think the winner of the 3rd Place

Match will be. You won't pick a team, but the Group the
team will come from. Rank all eight (8) groups in who you think the team will come out of (e.g., D,E,A,C,B,H,F,G).
The first group will be compared and if no one picked the right group, the second group will be compared, etc.
c. If both a) and b) don't yield a winner, then the players will be tied.

The Point System (196 points possible, same as the NCAA Pool) will be:

1. 48 Round-Robin Matches $=1$ point/match (48)
2. 16 Round of 16 teams $=3$ points/team (48)
3. 8 Round of 16 winners $=5$ points/team (40)
4. 4 Quarterfinal winners $=7$ points/team (28)
5. 2 Semifinal winners $=9$ points/team (18)
6. 1 World Cup 1998 Champion = 14 points (14)

(Tiebreakers: Total goals, Third-place winner (list 8 groups))

This system should be compatible with the NCAA Pool program we use, unless someone gets more than 32 of 48 correct in the Round Robin. Also, in the Round Robin, there are ties, and those will be a wash. We're trying to keep it as simple as possible. About $1 / 5$ th of these matches end up in a tie, meaning about 9-10 ties.

The World Cup begins June 10 and ends July 12. There are matches held nearly every day and I will post updates periodically. Although you may submit entries now, we won't be soliciting them until late May when I will email the Round Robin matches and brackets out. Since the World Cup is only held every four years, the fee to enter will likely be $\$ 10.00$, the same as the NCAA one. CAVEMAN should be able to cover that multiple times :-) We are expecting about 10 entries, although outside sources may bring in more. There is likely to be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prize roughly split 57/27/16\% like the NCAA pool.

Meanwhile, in case you missed it, here are the possible HWCI NCAA winners of this year's pool depending which one of the eight possibilities happen. Tomorrow's \#1E UNC-\#3W Utah matchup (2nd game of the day) will provide the most answers in how the pool will end up.

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## KENTUCKY GETS LUCKY AGAINST STANFORD；UTAH BUILDS LEAD IT NEVER GAVE UP

It will be Anna Come Lately，Caveman，and The Fabone for the top 3 spots
\＃3MW Stanford lost one of their men to a 5th foul on a ticky－tack call， did not get the possession after Kentucky missed a slam dunk（how？）， and got a＂jump ball＂only to have possession arrow pointing Kentucky＇s way all in the overtime period and almost pulled it off anyway．But， it will be \＃2S Kentucky who will go to Monday＇s Championship Game，their 3rd straight trip to the Finals．

Had Stanford made it，we could have had a \＃3 seed matchup as \＃3W Utah took down their 2nd straight \＃1 seed（\＃1W Arizona being the other）．Utah built a 28－12 lead over \＃1E North Carolina and never relenquished the lead， although UNC came within two points late in the game．UNC＇s atrocious shooting，both from the free throw line，normal range，and 3－point range spelled their doom．In the year where all four \＃1 seeds were supposed to make it to the Final 4，not one will now make it to the Final．

ANNA COME LATELY rode Utah's giant-killers all the way to the $\$ 150$ jackpot. As the only one who picked Utah to get past Arizona, the extra 14 points made her the "king (er.. queen) of the world" (quoting James Cameron quoting Jack Dawson quoting Cameron). ANNA becomes our first female winner of any prize. CAVEMAN will take home the $\$ 70$ prize, and yours truly, THE FABONE will take home $\$ 40$, which only pays for the previous $\$ 40$ I've put in the past 4 years. However, the $\$ 20$ fourth-place prize won't be decided until literally the last basket of Monday night. ## KENTUCKY RALLIES AGAIN TO CLAIM 2ND TITLE IN 3 YEARS Scottman joins the money gang，claiming fourth place

Put \＃2S Kentucky down by 10 or more in the second half and watch the Wildcats win．Each of Kentucky＇s last three games saw them trail by double－digits in the second half．Like the previous two games，KY exploded late in the second half and quickly went from four down to three up late in the game and eventually held off the \＃3W Utah，78－69，at the Alamodome in San Antonio．It was Kentucky＇s second NCAA title in the past 3 years（won in＇ 96 ，lost in＇ 97 ）．The Utes ran out of gas as the game wore on and couldn＇t hold onto the lead．

More importantly，with the total points at 147 for tonight＇s game，the fourth place prize of $\$ 20$ goes to SCOTTMAN，who was off by just one point（146），the best guess of the pack．JAYBIAN III was only
off by 2 (145). The four-way tie for fourth place was broken with the game, with the final order being SCOTTMAN, BUCKEYE MIKE (off by 11), MONEY (17), and POINT MAN (41). Also, SNOW SPICE (5) claimed eighth over PIPI GIRL (26); KADIAN (13) breaks the 3-way tie for 12th, leaving EN FUEGO (18), and JOON (146) for 13th and 14th; FOOT DOCTOR (8) takes 16th over ALL 2 EASY (10) and LUCKY FROM SF (13); and LENNY (13) will take little joy of just getting 25th place over PREKI THE BOMB (16) thanks to a late Utah 3-pointer and two free throws.

For the second straight year, no one picked the NCAA Champion ANNA COME LATELY, our champion, had Utah to win it all but fell short. However, her 13-point margin of victory set a new HWCI NCAA record, beating out JAYBIAN's 5-point victory in 1996.

# NCAA Final Recap (3/30/98) 

## [ The Rules | How to Enter | Standings | Links | For the Record | Scott's Latest Update]

SAN ANTONIO (FinalFour.net)-- The Kentucky Wildcats capped a memorable NCAA championship with a come-from-behind 78-69 win against the Utah Utes in front of 40,509 in San Antonio that will have fans across the nation saying, "Remember the Alamodome."

Kentucky, led by first-year head coach Orlando "Tubby" Smith, simply would not be denied in reaching the title game as the Comeback Cats rallied from a 17-point second-half deficit to defeat Duke, 86-84, in the South regional final and then overcame a 10 -point margin to down a game Stanford Cardinal team, $86-85$, in overtime, in one national semifinal game.

Utah emerged as the Cinderella story after trouncing the defending national champions from Arizona, $76-51$, in the West regional final and then stopping perennial power North Carolina, 65-59, in the national semifinals.

Kentucky and Utah squared off for the third consecutive year in the NCAA tournament. Kentucky guard Jeff Sheppard, who was named the Final Four's most outstanding player, scored 16 points as the Wildcats roared back from a 12-point second-half deficit to capture the school's seventh national title.
