NETHERLANDS was more than happy to take a scoreless draw into the locker room after the first 45 minutes as they soaked up pressure and countered only when the opportunity rose .... Perhaps NED wanted to shorten the match due to injuries > MAARTEN STEKELENBURG was originally scratched from the semi-final and ARJEN ROBBEN is just now finding fitness ....

1st Half > The most impressive NED move in the first half came from JORIS MATHIJSEN (11th minute) when he cleared a SERGIO RAMOS cross just yards in front of his goalmouth -99% of the time the ball finds the net ... NED again found some luck (28th minute) when thug NIGEL DE JONG should have been sent off with his chest-high karate kick ...

2<sup>nd</sup> Half > NED has their best look at the Rimet Trophy when ROBBEN got loose down the middle in the (61<sup>st</sup> minute) but IKER CASILLAS made a foot-save despite leaning the wrong way ... MATHIJSEN continued his eventful night (69<sup>th</sup> minute) when he too made a foot-block on DAVID VILLA's point-blank shot ... ESP again could have scored (77<sup>th</sup> minute) when RAMOS has a free CK header sail high ...

**Extra-Time** > ESPs CECH FABREGAS got free in L/box (95<sup>th</sup> minute) and saw MAARTEN STEKELENBURG foot-save his try ... INIESTA rammed home the winning goal (116<sup>th</sup> minute) R/Footed > L/Left on a pass from Fabregas ...
