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The (Preliminary) 1999 HWC I NCAA Tournament Pool Page

Greetings, salutations, and welcome to the (Preliminary) 1999 HWC I NCAA Tournament Page! Why preliminary? Because the tournament field hasn't been announced yet. That doesn't happen until this Sunday afternoon (March 7). Sometime Sunday night, the real (liminary?) 1999 HWC I NCAA Tournament Page will be posted in this space. Then begins the mad scramble to gather as many entries as possible before the first tournament games begin Thursday morning. As was the case with previous years, our little pool will feature timely scoring updates sent via email and posted on this web site. The entry fee is still \$10, and all entry money goes back out as prize money. Pool changes, entry procedures, and rules are detailed below. (Check out last year's dazzling page [here](#)) That's it for now, remember to check back here after Sunday night. Good luck!

What's New?

1. Recruiting incentives

For every 5 entrants you recruit into the pool, you will receive one free entry. Remember, statistically, having 2 entries instead of one doubles your chances of winning. There is a limit of 3 paid entries per person, but there is no limit to the free entries gained through recruiting. For example, if you recruit in 20 people, you can have anywhere from 4 (free) to 7 (4 free, 3 paid) entries (and if you *still* don't win any prize money, then you must really suck).

2. Web entry

This year you will be able to submit entries through this web site. This means that instead of

Having to endure the cumbersome act of typing out your entries, or manually filling out newspaper xeroxes, you can enter with a few clicks of the mouse.

How to Enter

1. Get thee a copy of the NCAA Men's Tournament Bracket. The most convenient place to get one would be the sports section of your local newspaper. You can also get the brackets at various sports related web sites. If you are planning to enter online via this web site (available Sunday night, March 7th), skip to step 6 below.
2. Fill out the brackets completely using all the college basketball wisdom you can conjure up.
3. Make a prediction for the total combined score for the championship game. For instance, if you think the final score will be 82-76, your prediction would be 158.
4. Create a nickname for yourself. This is important, because if you don't give us one, we'll make one up for you. Historically, these assigned nicknames have not been flattering.
5. Send all that precious information this-away before the first game on Thursday, March 11. Obviously, the fastest way to get the info here is by e-mail (dfeng@hwci.com and smt2@hwci.com). However, you can also send it via snail mail, so long as it is post marked by March 11th. Those going the e-mail route will have to manually type in all your picks. The most efficient way of completing this tedious task is to send in your picks as follows:

6. And finally, you must send your entry fee of \$10 to me at the address immediately above. Are we trustworthy enough to trust us with your credit card numbers? Yes! Are we technologically sophisticated enough to offer that option? No! Hence checks are the preferable means of payment. All entry fees must be paid by Thursday, March 18. Remember, if you have any questions, address them to dfeng@hwci.com or to smt2@hwci.com.

The Rules

Who's eligible to join the pool?

Anyone and everyone (members of participating NCAA programs might want to consider carefully, though ;-)).

What are the requirements?

The only requirements are that the \$10 entry fee is paid before the round of 16 games have begun, and that the pertinent entry information is received before the start of the tournament. The pertinent entry information would include:

- Real name
- Preferred nickname (I am the Mighty Mobelfakta, so that name's taken already).
- Email address or phone number.
- Prediction for the total combined score of the championship game (for tie-breaking purposes).
- Predicted winners of all 63 tournament games.

How are the points scored?

2 points for each 1st round win

3 points for each 2nd round win

4 points for each 3rd round win

6 points for each 4th round win

8 points for each 5th round win

12 points for correctly picking the NCAA Champion

There is no weighting for "upsets".

How is the prize money distributed?

Last year with 28 entries, there was a first, second, third, and fourth place prize. The \$280.00 pot was split as follows: 1st-\$150.00, 2nd-\$70.00, 3rd-\$40.00, and 4th-\$20.00. This year the money will be split with roughly the same proportions going to the winners.

What if there's a tie?

The participant whose prediction comes closest (higher or lower) for the final combined score of the championship game will win the tie-breaker. If there is STILL a tie, the money will be split. For instance, if there is a tie for first place, the winners will split the combined prize money for first and second place. FYI, in four years of running this pool, there has only been one tie for prize money.

Can I enter more than once?

You certainly can. Statistically, your chances of winning would double. However, so far of the four people (eight entries) who have tried their luck with two entries, none have taken home any prize money. Go figure.

every game! Each year since 1995 we've increased our number of

entries. Last year we had 28 entries, with first place winning \$150.

<http://www.hwci.com/ncaa>. Here are the basics:

-the entry fee is still \$10

-all entry fee money goes back out as prize money

-standing updates are sent out via email and posted on the web page

There are a couple changes noted below (recruiting incentives and web based entry). Detailed rules and procedures can also be found below.

If you're worried about the fee, don't. If you've received this letter, I know you're good for the money, so don't stress about getting the

entry to me in time. The tournament seedings are announced Sunday afternoon, and then the entries can start rolling in. Let me know if you have any questions.

WHAT'S NEW?

1. Recruiting incentives

For every 5 entrants you recruit into the pool, you will receive one free entry. Remember, statistically, having 2 entries instead of one doubles your chances of winning. There is a limit of 3 paid entries per person, but there is no limit to the free entries gained through recruiting.

For example, if you recruit in 20 people, you can have anywhere from 4 (free) to 7 (4 free, 3 paid) entries (and if you still don't win any prize money, then you must really suck).

2. Web entry

This year you will be able to submit entries through our web site.

This means that instead of having to endure the cumbersome act of typing out

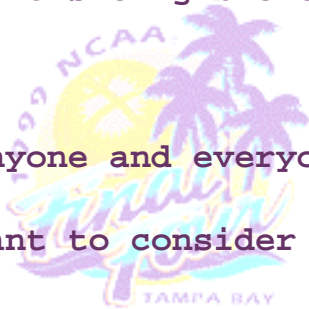


THE RULES

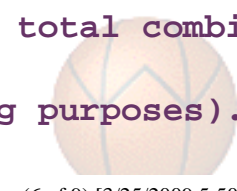
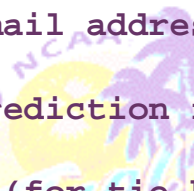

-How are the points scored?

2 points for each 1st round win

3 points for each 2nd round win

6 points for each 4th round win

8 points for each 5th round win

12 points for correctly picking the NCAA Champion

There is no weighting for "upsets".

-How is the prize money distributed?

Last year with 28 entries, there was a first, second, third, and fourth place prize. The \$280.00 pot was split as follows: 1st-\$150.00, 2nd-\$70.00, 3rd-\$40.00, and 4th-\$20.00. This year the money will be split with roughly the same proportions going to the winners.

-What if there's a tie?

The participant whose prediction comes closest (higher or lower)

for the final combined score of the championship game will win the tie-breaker. If there is STILL a tie, the money will be split. For instance, if there is a tie for first place, the winners will split the combined prize money for first and second place. UNC LOSS A STUNNER WHILE UCLA'S LOSS IS NOT

Over 30 entries received setting new record

EL SEGUNDO, CA (smt)- Well, UCLA was # 5 seed, not #4,

the region is South not Southeast, the year is 1999 not 1996. However, it was still Indianapolis and there was still the same result as a poor shooting #12S-Detroit team beat #5S-UCLA; however, that wasn't as surprising as #14W-Weber St. knocking off #3W-UNC. #2W-Stanford nearly gets beat while #1S-Auburn blazes by #16-Winthrop. Two #10 seeds, #10W-Gonzaga (over #7W-Minn) and #10S-Creighton (over #7W-Louisville) advance as do the two #9 seeds (#9S-OK St. and #9W-New Mexico). #4S-Ohio St., #6S-Indiana (196 pts scored in that game with #11S-George Washington), #3S-St. John's, and

#2S-Maryland win easily in the South region. #1W-UConn, #5W-Iowa, #4W-Arkansas, and #6W-Florida pull out double-digit wins in the West.

I apologize for getting this update a day late, but I was at the US soccer match last night and we are still trying to finalize the entries. After the first 8 games, three people (FREE FABONE, MAX POWER, THE FABONE V) went 8-0 but at the end of the day, CHRIS and MAX POWER topped the day with 26 points (13 wins). YELLOWMONKEY brings up the rear in 36th place with just 14 points. Three people had UNC going to the Final Four and will have to hope for some more upsets (DARKSHARK had UNC winning it all-whoops!). 29 of 35 people have Duke going all the way with all but one person (SHAW) having them make the Final Four. UConn was picked by 4 to go all the way while UNC, Arizona, and Michigan St. were picked by one person each. Just three picked Detroit over UCLA (had I not been a "homer", I would've picked Detroit) while TIGER gets the token prize for picking the huge Weber St. upset of UNC. The closest game was New Mexico-Missouri as slightly more than half (19 of 36) picked New Mexico correctly.

ARIZONA RETURNS TO OLD SELF IN LOSING WHILE DUKE BEGINS ITS MARCH

Shary Bobbins goes 14-2 to tie Chris for first place

EL SEGUNDO/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- #13MW-Oklahoma scored the last

five points in the final minute to upset #4MW-Arizona, becoming the 2nd #13 seed to advance. Arizona used to be known for choking in the first round in the 90's but then they won it all in 1997. I guess old habits have returned. All #9 and #10 seeds advanced as #9E-Tulsa, #9MW-Ole Miss, #10E-Purdue, and #10MW-Miami, Ohio won close games. One of the best matchups saw #5MW-UNCC hold off #12MW-Rhode Island in overtime. #12E-SW Missouri St. upset #5E-Wisconsin helping give lower

seeded teams a 12-20 record in the first round. #1E-Duke (won by 41 but didn't cover the spread), #4E-Tenn, #6E-Temple, #3E-Cincy, #2E-Miami, Fla. won handily in the East region while #1MW-Michigan St., #6MW-Kansas, #3MW-Kentucky, and #2MW-Utah took their games in the Midwest.

Last year the Pac-10 was 4-0 in the first round with 4 teams in the Sweet Sixteen and this year they are 1-3 with Stanford barely holding on for the lone Pac-10 win. Wally Szczerbiak of Miami, Ohio scored 43 of his team's 59 points to help upset Washington. His point total is exactly what SW Missouri St. scored to beat Wisconsin (43-32).

Arizona's loss prevented CHRIS from going 8-0 in the first half of the day but no one picked Oklahoma. Eight picked SW Missouri St. and nine picked Ole Miss. CHRIS is tied with SHARY BOBBINS for first with 52 points (ties HWC I record) but CHRIS has 2 of his 4 Final Four teams out of the tourney. MAX POWER and SHAW are tied for third with 48 points while there is an 11-way tie for fifth with 46 points. TRUEBRUIN sets a new HWC I record low by going 7-9 today and 17-13 in the first round (she ties the 1st round day record low set by YELLOWMONKEY yesterday with a 7-9 mark).

Had you picked all the favorites you would have gone 10-6 on Thursday and 10-6 today, so if you have more than 40 points, you did better than blindly picking favorites.

MIAMI ADVANCES BUT IT'S OF OHIO, NOT FLORIDA AS TOP SEEDS FALL

Max Power powers to first with six of eight correct

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The Sweet Sixteen will feature five

double-digit seeds (three #10, one #12, and one #13 seeds) for the first time ever as five top seeds fell today. #12E-SW Missouri St. rolled all over #4E-Tennessee, #6E-Temple took care of #3E-Cincy (who once again failed to live up to expectations), #10E-Purdue suprised #2E-Miami, FL, #13MW-Okalahoma beat #5MW-UNCC, and #10MW-Miami, OH muscled their way past #2MW-Utah. The best matchup was classic as #3MW-Kentucky needed overtime to take care of a

young #6MW-Kansas team. Even #1MW-Michigan St. struggled with #9-Mississippi before pulling away. The only constant was #1E-Duke walloping #9E-Tulsa by 41 points (the same margin as Duke's first round win over Florida A&M).

The Big Ten puts four teams in the Sweet Sixteen with Purdue in the East, Michigan St. in the Midwest, Ohio St. in the South, and Iowa in the West. Three of the four Final Four teams from last year are out (Kentucky nearly made it all four) with Utah losing today and Stanford and UNC losing earlier this week.

Just three people picked SW Missouri St., just four picked Temple, and only one picked Purdue. And MAX POWER did all three to easily win the day with a 6-2 record and took over first place with 81 points. TRUE BRUIN continues to set all types of record lows with least wins today (tied with 2), least wins in second round (5), and least points after 2 rounds (43). But the news is bad for others as well as seven people have been eliminated from any money and only 20 can have a chance to win first place (see website for details).

GONZAGA LEADS PACK OF SURPRISES- BUT WILL ANYONE STOP DUKE?

Twenty people can still win first and get half of \$360 pot

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- It's been two days since the madness

stopped so that the sports world can get their heads together for the next wave of NCAA games. Here are my Sweet 16 thoughts:

1. DUKE- Can it get any easier for them? It would have still

been laughable if they had to face #8 Charleston, #4 Tenn, and #2 Miami, FL in their next three games but now instead they faced #9 Tulsa, will play #12 SW Missouri St., and then either #6 Temple

or #10 Purdue. The rich get richer.

2. CBS- They can't handle more than one game going on at a time. They're brainless. It's unfantomable to wait 30 minutes for a score of a close game. It's worse when 10 of those 30 minutes are commercials.

3. GONZAGA- Huh? They out hustled and outrebounded Stanford. They've earned respect and could make the Elite 8. Will they now change their name?

4. PAC 10- It couldn't get any worse (unless USC made it).

5. MIAMI- Who would have guessed it would be Miami of Ohio and not Miami of Florida that would be in the Sweet 16.

6. KANSAS VS KENTUCKY. Now that's a classic matchup. Too bad it happened in the second round.

7. WALLY. Wally Szczerbiak of Miami of Ohio single-handedly led them to a first round win by scoring 43 of Miami's 59 points.

8. SW Missouri St- The #12 seed stifled #5 Wisconsin to an amazingly low 32 points then went out and whipped #4 Tennessee. Too bad they have to face Duke.

9. FLORIDA A&M- The poor team met Duke in the first round. The good news is they covered the 46 point spread.

10. NAMES- What's with the similar names? Kent/Kentucky. Stanford/Sanford. Miami of Florida/Florida/Florida A&M.

Ole Miss/Missouri/SW Missouri St. Oklahoma/Oklahoma St.
Miami of Ohio/Miami of Florida.

11. UCLA- Another first round exit in Indianapolis. Well, at least Coach Steve Lavin didn't cry like last year (though he should have- it was a pitiful performance).

12. #1 SEEDS- Although #1S-Auburn and #1MW-Michigan St. had some problems in the second round, this could be the first year all four #1 seeds made it to the Final Four since the field expanded to 64 teams.

13. TEMPLE VS PURDUE- Great matchup here. Too bad the winner loses in the Elite 8.

14. SOUTH REGION- The only region where things made sense with the top four seeds advancing. Only 4 of the other 12 top seeds in the other regions advanced.

15. CINCINNATI- It's good to know that in one of the most unpredictable tournaments, you can always count on high seeded Cincy to not make the Sweet 16.

16. DUKE- They're so good I gotta mention them twice.

THE POOL: MAX POWER used a strong 2nd round to take over first place with 81 points. CHRIS (79 pts) is right behind with SHARY

BOBBINS (76) in third. Of the 36 entrants, 29 still have a shot at some money but only 20 still have a chance for first place.

Speaking of money, the pot has been divided.

First place = \$180 \

Second place = \$90 \ Total pot =

Third place = \$60 / \$360.00

Forth place = \$30 /

Just eight people have their Final Four teams intact. Even with that, THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA (59) joins six others as being the first ones to be eliminated this year. SHAW (69) has 3 of his 4 Final Four teams out but still has a chance for first place, believe it or not.

In four previous pools, five people have submitted two entries and so far none of them have won. So it doesn't look good for THE FABONE V (73) and FREE FABONE (71), despite clinging to 4th and 7th place, respectively. Heading into the Sweet 16, SHARY BOBBINS has the best chance (34.4%) of finishing first while MAX POWER has the best chance of winning any money (69.6%) after all is said and done. Of the 32,768 possible outcomes, JAYLOC can win money on just 24 of them (0.07%). The standings can change rapidly. In 1995, our first year, LOSER WHO DIDN'T PICK UCLA was 11th (of 12 entrants)

after the first round, picked 14 of 16 in the second round to take over first place, then got none of his final four teams in to end the pool dead last. More info can be found at:

GONZAGA CONTINUES CINDERELLA RUN WHILE FIRST #1 SEED FALLS

Shary Bobbins leads pack of ten in battle for first place

LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- #10W-Gonzaga got some luck when Brent Wright

of #6W-Florida was called for traveling with 15.4 seconds left setting

up Gonzaga's winning basket. Gonzaga will face top seeded #1W-UConn

who struggled against #5W-Iowa before pulling away late. In the

South, #4S-Ohio St. rallied from 6 points down and exploded on a 9-0 run to break open a 61-61 tie to topple #1S-Auburn, the first

#1 seed to fall in the tourney. #3S-St. John's had earlier used

a 20-0 run to close the first half en route to beating #2S-Maryland.

St. John's is arguably the hottest team outside of Duke.

If you had picked all the favorites in the tournament, you would have pitiful 68 points (just four have less than 68 points). In prior years, picking all the favorites would put you near the top. This year, SHARY BOBBINS (1st place, 88 pts) was one of five people to go 3-1 and has all but clinched a money spot (97.46%) and has nearly a 3/4ths chance of winning the first prize payoff of \$180. Scott HW's two picks are currently tied for second (THE FABONE V, 85) and fourth (FREE FABONE, 83) but history has shown that those who enter twice, don't win (5 people, 0-10). MAX POWER (2nd, 85) holds onto a tie for 2nd despite going 1-3. CHRIS (4th, 83) falls from second to a tie for fourth place. YELLOWMONKEY is in 25th place with 71 points but still has a slight chance to win first.

The St. John's-Maryland game had everyone's attention as everyone either picked St. John or Maryland. St. John's win sent four more people into the elimination ranks (KUYA GLENN, JAYBIAN V, CANTONA, JAYLOC). Just six people picked Ohio St. and this sent six more people home tearing up their bracket (SHAW, LEONARDO, Q, TAMO, TIGER, LEGEND). 34 of 36 picked UConn to win. TRUE BRUIN (36th, 49) set a new HWC NCAA record by going winless today and her only bright

spot is she picked Duke to win it all. This was the first time no one went 4-0. SHAW (8th, 77) is the only one person who has all of his Final Four picks gone (after Kentucky's game tomorrow, he becomes a pool spectator) while SHARY BOBBINS is the only person who has a chance to get all four picks in.

SMS PLAYS DUKE CLOSE (FOR A HALF) AS THE FAVORITES FINALLY DOMINATE

Shary Bobbins reaches century mark as pool tightens up

IRVINE/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- For the first time in the tournament

there were no upsets as #1E-Duke, #6E-Temple, #1MW-Michigan St., and #3MW-Kentucky all advanced against their lower seeded opponents.

#12E-SW Missouri St. played Duke tough in the first half and trailed by only nine at halftime before the inevitable happened. Temple

easily took care of #10E-Purdue. Michigan St. pulled away late in the game to keep #13MW-Oklahoma at bay. #10MW-Miami of Ohio

battled Kentucky tough for most of the game before the Wildcats broke it open.

In the pool, SHARY BOBBINS (1st, 100) hit 100 points and there are now only 4 of 128 possible outcomes she won't win at least fourth place. The FABONES (THE FABONE V, 2nd, 93 and FREE FABONE, 3rd, 91) position themselves for a money spot but the race has tightened thanks to the favorites winning today. CHRIS (3rd, 91) with Michigan St. as his champ is very much in it. Kentucky will be the key for about seven people while five will rely on St. John's. MAX POWER (5th, 89) who picked 11 of 16 Sweet Sixteen teams just picked 2 of 8 Elite 8 teams and can't finish higher than 3rd place. Six people went 3-1 today but SHARY BOBBINS and BUCKEYE MIKE topped the round picking 6 of 8. SHARY BOBBINS is the only one to have all four of her Final Four teams alive. TRUE BRUIN (36th, 53) is guaranteed to finish in dead last and the worst point total in HWCII NCAA history thanks to Kentucky's win propelling SHAW (16th, 81) to his final point total of 81. Just THE FABONE V (2nd, 93) picked Temple correctly while 35 of 36 picked Duke. Michigan St.'s win knocked off two more from money contention (KEIKOSAURUS, KNIEVELKID) and left just nine vying for first place.

UCONN FINALLY MAKES FINAL FOUR AS OHIO ST. HOLDS OFF ST. JOHN'S

Shary Bobbins clinches at least 4th place with eye on \$180 prize

PASADENA/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- #10W-Gonzaga's cinderella run

is over though they played top seed #1W-UConn close. Gonzaga led at halftime 32-31 before bowing out at the end, 67-62. UConn makes the Final Four for the first time ever after several disappointing attempts this decade. #4S-Ohio St. nearly blew a late 13-point lead to #3S-St. John's to make the Final Four for the first time since 1968. Ohio St. contributed to the near collapse by missing free throws and committing silly fouls but it was St. John's who missed

one of two free throws that would have tied the game at 75. Michael Redd led the Buckeyes in the first half while Scoonie Penn took over in the second half, including hitting some key 3-pt baskets everytime St. John's came close. Ohio St. never trailed. UConn and Ohio St. will play the second game of Saturday's Final Four doubleheader in Tampa.

Just two people (FREE FABONE and SHARY BOBBINS) went 2-0 today while 15 went 0-2. UConn's win was picked by 20 people and eliminated MINO, YELLOWMONKEY, and SHAKERMAKER. Only three people (SHARY BOBBINS, THE FABONE V, and FREE FABONE) picked Ohio St. and three more people were eliminated from money spots (RED, BOB BRUINS, and BUCKEYE MIKE). This leaves just 11 in the running for a piece of the \$360 pot and just two for the first prize of \$180 (SHARY BOBBINS and CHRIS). CHRIS is still in it since he picked Michigan St. to win it all.

SHARY BOBBINS (1st, 112) clinched a money spot with Ohio St.'s win and there are only 2 scenarios (of 32) where she won't win first. FREE FABONE (2nd, 103) topped the century mark with THE FABONE V (3rd, 99) holding 3rd place. BIG SPIDER BECK (20th, 84), despite being in 20th place, still has a chance to win 4th place.

TEMPLE NO MATCH FOR DUKE AS MICHIGAN ST. OUTLASTS KENTUCKY

Bobbins will take at least 2nd as eight vie for other three spots

LITTLE TOKYO/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- For the second straight game,

#1E-Duke struggled for the first half, but like all four games Duke has played, they've blown out their opponent in the second half.

#6E-Temple tried to make a late run, cutting the lead to 10, but Duke ran away after that to win by 21, 85-64. Although some say

#3MW-Kentucky would have been a better opponent for Duke, it will be

#1MW-Michigan St. instead as they overcame an early 17-4 deficit

to win 73-66. Michigan St. dethrones the defending champs and reaches

the Final Four for the first time since 1979. It was Duke's fifth Final Four in the 90's but the first since 1994. One streak will end on Saturday: Michigan St. has a 22-game winning streak and Duke has a 31-game winning streak.

While 34 picked Duke to make the Final Four, only six had Michigan St. going this far and so, six people went 2-0.

SHAW (30th, 81) and DARKSHARK (25th, 88) were the only two to go 0-2 for the day and are the only two who went 0-4 for the round.

Five went 3-1 for the round. Duke's win sent DARKSHARK moneyless and Michigan St.'s win eliminated THE FLYING ELVI (9th, 98).

The pool picture is a tad clearer. SHARY BOBBINS (1st, 118) will take home at least \$90 and is the odds-on favorite to win first.

CHRIS (5th, 103), who had UNC and UCLA, two of his Final Four picks, knocked out in the first round still has a chance to win first, provided Michigan St. beats Ohio St. in the final. Besides these two, seven others will battle the money spots. FREE FABONE (2nd, 109) and CARSERONI (4th, 104) will each have six chances (of 8) to win money but CARSERONI has the inside edge since Michigan St. and Ohio St. would have to advance to the final for him to lose money

while FREE FABONE will lose if Duke wins it all, the most likely scenario.

FIVE YEARS HAS PRODUCED FIVE DIFFERENT WINNERS

\$1,070 will have been distributed to over 12 different people

EL SEGUNDO/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The 5th HWCI NCAA Tournament

Pool will produce its 5th different champion, as Lisa T (aka, SHARY BOBBINS) or Chris R (aka, CHRIS) will take home the \$180 top prize. James L (aka, BIG GAME), who won 3rd in 1996 and 2nd in 1998, will try to go 3-for-3 with a money spot this year (he didn't play in 1995 or 1997). Scott T (aka, THE FABONE V and FREE FABONE) will try to become the first person (five others have tried before) to win any money when entering twice. The pool,

from its modest beginnings in 1995 when just 12 people participated, has tripled in size with a pot of \$360.

A little history.....

In 1995, the first year of the pool, just 12 people entered in a modest effort put forth by HW-UCLA and their close friends. Names like BAD ASS and LIVER BOY graced the pool. Of course, their interest was heightened because UCLA was favored to win it all. Indeed, 10 of 12 picked UCLA while 2 picked Kentucky. This pool featured the infamous LOSER WHO DIDN'T PICK UCLA (Dennis K) who set an all-time record with a 14-2 2nd Round to go from tied for 9th to tied for 1st before going 0-7 in the final 3 rounds to finish dead last (12th) with 98 points. TINA'S BOY (Mark C) became the first person to be eliminated when the 2nd round ended. He is, however, one of only 3 people (all in 1995) to correctly pick the two teams in the final and the champion. BIX PIX (Fernando B, 1st, 148) and MR. NELSON (Nelson, 2nd, 146) were the other two and claimed the top two spots, winning \$70 and \$30, respectively. THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA (3rd, 141) claimed third prize worth \$20. All but one finished with 110 points or more, the highest scoring pool ever (130.6 average).

In 1996, 19 people participated in the pool. Without the HW-UCLA guys picking nicknames, we had some boring stuff like JAMES, JOSEPH, and HEATHER. That year, the total points tiebreaker was first used to settle ties. A newcomer, JAYBIAN (Jason S, 1st, 144) rode Kentucky to a first place prize of \$110. He also set a record going 8-0 for the 3rd round and never looked back. BIX PIX TWEY (Fernando B, 5th, 129) hoping to duplicate last year's effort, fell short of winning money thanks to his loyalty to UCLA. JOSEPH (Joseph K, 2nd, 140) and JAMES (James L, 3rd, 139) won \$50 and \$30, respectively. Six picked Kentucky that year with just as many picking UCLA (who lost to Princeton in the first round- ouch!). This was the first year someone entered twice (Dave F) and ended up 11th (REALISTIC MOBELFAKTA, 113) and 16th (THE MIGHTY MOBELFAKTA, 106). MM and HATE THE DUCKS (Mark C, 12th, 112) became the 2nd and 3rd people to go 0-for-the-Final-Four. HATE THE DUCKS had a 64% chance of winning money heading into the 4th round, and 0% chance after. THE CHEF (Douglas H, 19th, 80) set an all-time low in points for a pool.

In 1997, the first real debate on whether to raise the pool fee to \$20 from \$10 was raised. Fortunately, it was defeated in a vote. But, three people did plunk down \$20 to enter twice as 22 entries

were received in the third annual pool. Like Dave F before them, the three people went moneyless (Tuan H- RODERICK (15th, 97) and RHODES (14th, 97); Alvin K- BAD ASS I (4th, 111) and BAD ASS II (18th, 93); and Dennis K- LENNY (6th, 107) and DUKE (12th, 99)). This was also the first year no one picked the correct NCAA champion. Arizona, who usually bowed out in the first or second round, surprised everyone, including Kentucky, in winning the championship in overtime. The #4SE seed beat three # 1 seeds, the first time that's happened. Twelve had picked Kansas and four North Carolina, neither which made the championship game. MAX (Sean D, 1st, 116) bounced back from a 15th place finish the year before to win the \$125 top prize. The brothers Selander took 2nd (Brian S, THE FLYING ELVI, 2nd, 115) and 3rd (Jason S, JAYBIAIN II, 3rd, 113) for \$60 and \$35, respectively. Jason S became the first person to win money twice (1st in 1996). Just half (11 of 22) finished 100 points or higher.

In 1998, a record 28 entries tried their luck. ANNA COME LATELY (Anna, 1st, 126), the last entry we received, seemed like the least likely to win, picking a Utah over UCLA final. Well, Utah surprised the 27 other entrants (no one else even had them in the Final Four) and gave ANNA COME LATELY the record top prize of \$150. James L

became the 2nd person to win twice taking the \$70 second place prize (CAVEMAN, 2nd, 113) while THE FABONE (Scott T, 3rd, 110) won money for the first time in four tries to take home \$40. For the first time, a 4th place prize was created and that went to SCOTTMAN (Scott H, 4th, 108), which was also the first time the tiebreaker played a part in the top spots as SCOTTMAN won the 4-way tie for 4th place. With Kentucky's rally and win over Utah in the final, this was the 2nd straight year no one picked the champion. Sixteen pegged UNC while five hoped for an Arizona repeat. UTHOPE (Donald G, 24th, 92) became the 4th person to go 0-7 in the last three rounds. This was also the lowest scoring pool ever (98.1 average) despite 20 of 28 scorers 100 or better. ANNA COME LATELY's 13-point win was the largest margin of victory ever. Tuan H once again entered twice with the same results- no money (STRAIGHT BUTTER, 10th, 106 and EN FUEGO, 13th, 104) extending the drought for dual entries to 0-for-5.

In 1999, a record 36 entries (18 NCAA pool newcomers, 13 pool newcomers if you include those who participated in the World Cup Pool) were received with only one dual entry (Scott T- THE FABONE V and FREE FABONE). The record pot of \$360 will be split \$180/\$90/\$60/\$30. We already know that Mark C (DARKSHARK) will become the first person to go 0-for-7 twice (1996) and that SHARY BOBBINS (Lisa T) will become

the 12th different person to win HWCI NCAA pool money. This weekend will tell how this pool will end up. Will Scott T break the streak of winless dual entries? Will it be the third straight year no one has picked the correct NCAA champion (if Ohio St. wins)? How low will TRUE BRUIN (Loretta A), currently at 59 points, go? Will James L (BIG GAME) win money for the third time? Will Duke, picked by 29 of 36 people, win it all as expected? Will BIG SPIDER BECK (Fernando B), who had a 4 in 128 (1 in 32) chance of winning money, do so (now 1 in 8)? It'll be fun...

FINALLY, THE NICKNAMES MAKE SENSE (WELL, NOT REALLY)

It's Duke's Final Four to lose as tournament resumes Saturday

EL SEGUNDO/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- The Final Four begins this Saturday with the two semifinal games with #4S-Ohio St. (27-8) taking on 5 1/2-point favorite #1W-UConn (32-2) in the first game and then 11-point favorite #1E-Duke (36-1) taking on #1MW-Michigan St (33-4). This Final Four seems to be about the dominance of Duke and the coaches. Mike Krzyzewski of Duke has been to the Final Four five

times in the 90's and has won two NCAA championships and is leading the highly favorite Duke Blue Devils easily through the tournament so far. Michigan St. coach Tom Izzo has lead the Spartans to a 22-game winning streak and two consecutive Big 10 titles after finishing below .500 in 1997. Ohio St. head coach Jim O'Brien was 2nd in the AP Coach of the Year voting after turning the Buckeyes' program after going 8-22 record last year. Jim Calhoun of Connecticut finally made it to the Final Four after many near misses. The Huskies have a 9-game winning streak. No team had advanced (until Ohio St.) to the Final Four without appearing in the NCAA tourney the year before. Only Krzyzewski has been to the Final Four before.

In the first game, Ohio St. coach Jim O'Brien (then at Boston College) has lost his last 18 meetings with UConn coach Jim Calhoun.

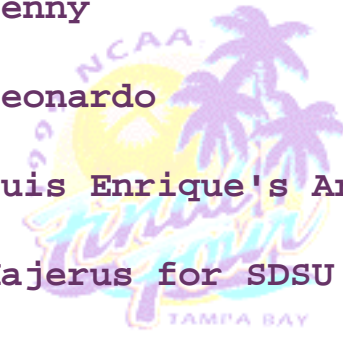
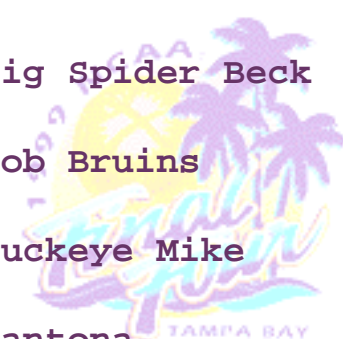
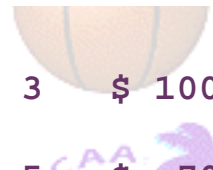
Also, Ohio State's team has been barricaded from the sights and sounds of Tampa while the other three teams are accessible. This could backfire and send UConn to their first national title game. The other game is a rematch of an earlier game in December where Duke nearly blew a 17-point lead before taking care of Michigan St. It's only one of three close games Duke has played all season. If Michigan St. once again starts off slow, Duke will likely win its 32nd straight game.

In the pool, if Ohio St. wins the first game, then Scott T will win some money (either with FREE FABONE or THE FABONE V or both) and LUIS ENRIQUE'S ARMADA and BIG SPIDER BECK will be eliminated. If UConn wins, then SHARY BOBBINS will win 1st, CARSERONI will win some money, and THE FABONE V will be eliminated. If, at the end of the day, it's a DUKE-OHIO ST final, SHARY BOBBINS will win 1st, Scott T will win 2nd (either with FREE FABONE or THE FABONE V), and CARSERONI will win 3rd or 4th. If it's a DUKE-UCONN final, then SHARY BOBBINS will win 1st and CARSERONI will win 2nd or 3rd. If it's a MICH ST-OHIO ST final, then CHRIS and SHARY BOBBINS will finish in the top two spots (1st-2nd or 2nd-1st) and FREE FABONE will take 3rd. If it's a MICH ST-UCONN final, then SHARY BOBBINS will win 1st and FREE FABONE will win either 2nd or 3rd.

Finally, here is the list of participants with their nicknames, the number of HWCi NCAA pools played (# years and # total entries), and money won. As you can see, half the entries are from first-time HWCi NCAA participants (18 of 36).

It's Duke's Final Four to lose as tournament resumes Saturday

EL SEGUNDO, CA (smt)- The only two teams to hold the #1 spot

during the regular season will meet in Monday's NCAA Final in Tampa. #1W-UConn held off mistake-prone #4S-Ohio St., 64-58, to advance to its first-ever final while #1E-Duke kept its distance from #1MW-Michigan St., 68-62. Duke held the #1 spot for all but 10 weeks during the regular season. Ohio St. missed some key free throws, misplayed some key rebounds (including the "It's mine!" incident, where two Buckeyes wrestled for the rebound and eventually were called for traveling), and missed key baskets down the stretch giving UConn the victory. Despite the near no-shows of Scoonie Penn (who misplaced his jersey) and Michael Redd, Ohio St. was in it until the end. The 2nd Big 10 team, Michigan St., also lost despite playing well. Duke is just near invincible, because they played okay, missed a lot of free throws, and got into foul trouble... yet, they still maintained their lead. It seemed like for a stretch of ten minutes in the second half, Michigan St. was getting all the rebounds, making all the shots, forcing Duke turnovers, but Duke would hit a 3-point shot and the lead always seemed to range from 7-10 points. I would ALMOST bet the house that Duke will win its 3rd NCAA title this decade. I think the key is to get Duke behind early, but that's hard to do.

This update is partly late because I was busy most of the

weekend and partly late cause I'm depressed my chances to win money went from very good to almost nil. Sigh. But, the pool was to have fun, right? SHARY BOBBINS (1st, 134) will have fun spending her \$180 winnings (now the most successful predictor, taking over Anna's \$150 win last year) as she clinched the top spot with UConn's win. LANGDON ONE STEP TOO MANY AS UCONN SHOCKS DUKE, 77-74

Free Fabone snaps curse while Big Spider Beck defies odds to take 4th

EL SEGUNDO/LA MIRADA, CA (smt)- Trajan Langdon of #1E-Duke

traveled (although it was obvious, I'm surprised the ref had the guts to call it) on their second to last possession and fell on Duke's last as time ran out to give #1W-UConn an improbable 77-74 win for their first NCAA Championship. It's kind of odd that this was one of the

biggest upsets in the final this decade considering UConn is arguably the second-best team in the nation. I said that the only way to beat Duke is keep them behind late in the game. If you are playing catch-up with Duke, forget it. UConn had the a rare run against Duke to go up 65-59. Of course, Duke fought back, but it was Duke who had to force the issues, not UConn. Not being used to a "pressure" situation of being behind after routing their previous five tournament opponents, you could say Duke was rusty and didn't make the big plays at the end. For once, both teams hit key free throws at the end of the game. Richard Hamilton lead the Huskies with 27 pts, and Khalid El-Amin hit 2 clutch free throws with 5.2 seconds left. Should Duke have called a timeout on either of their last two possessions before Langdon's follies? I'd say yes on the first possession when Duke got to halfcourt. Oh well. Duke finished 37-2 (ties record for most wins) and UConn 34-2. Duke suffered a rare double loss because its women's team lost in the final to Purdue on Sunday. Duke is still the better team though. Like the 2nd half of the Michigan St. game, the end of the first half saw UConn control the game but Duke was still in it, never letting UConn lead by more than 4. It seemed everytime UConn built a small 3-4 point lead, Duke would come back, then let UConn build that small 3-4 point lead, then come back again. The end of the

half saw Langdon hit a 3-pt shot to cut the UConn's 4-pt lead to one, then seconds later he converted a 4-pt play to put Duke up 39-36 before the half ended with Duke leading 39-37.

It was the first time in three years that someone picked the correct NCAA champion and three of the four people who picked UConn to win it all won money. As was decided on Saturday, SHARY BOBBINS (1st, 146) took first. Her 146 points ties for the 2nd most points earned in pool history. Scott T, who could have won money on 30 of 32 possibilities entering the Final Four, barely salvaged one money spot with FREE FABONE (2nd, 137) taking the \$90 2nd place prize. CARSERONI (3rd, 120), a questionable entry at first before confirmation, took third place while BIG SPIDER BECK (4th, 118), who had just 4 of 128 possibilities to win entering the Elite 8, took 4th place, his second win of the pool. BIG GAME (6th, 117) was denied a chance to win money three pools in a row. Scott T's win with FREE FABONE snapped a winless streak (0-for-5 record) of people who have entered twice. His other entry, THE FABONE V (10th, 113) finished 10th. TRUE BRUIN (36th, 67) finished with the lowest points in history and least wins in the tourney (25).

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla. (The Associated Press) -- Connecticut beat top-ranked Duke 77-74, in a thrilling game, for their first national championship in their first Final Four appearance.

The 77-74 thriller ended Duke's 32-game winning streak, kept the Blue Devils from an NCAA record for wins in a season, and prevented them from ending the 1990s with a third national championship.

Richard Hamilton led third-ranked Connecticut (34-2) with 27 points, but it was some tremendous team defense and a big shot and free throws by Khalid El-Amin that won it all.

Trajan Langdon led Duke (37-2) with 25 points, but Duke's last two possessions ended with him making turnovers. And so the Blue Devils fell short of what everyone had expected -- another title.

These were the only two teams to hold the No. 1 ranking this season and they played a final game worthy of the two best.

"We lost to a great basketball team. We were beaten tonight, we didn't lose," Duke coach Mike Krzyzewski said.

"We picked it up in the second half and we had some opportunities, but they put the pressure on us and were tough to defend," he said. "We got some good looks and had a chance to win, but they

made the play and we didn't make the play in the last minute."

Connecticut was able to keep the game at a pace it liked even though most everyone thought the Huskies should try to slow the tempo. The quick pace made for what seemed like constant lead changes, the last coming with 3:50 to play when Hamilton's free throws gave the Huskies a 70-68 lead.

He hit a 3-pointer 21 seconds later for a five-point lead and suddenly Duke was playing a role it had very little experience at this season -- the chaser.

"We're happy as heck, and we truly believed we could beat them," UConn coach Jim Calhoun said. "I said before the game that we hadn't played our best yet. If you count character, I think tonight we did."

William Avery's free throws with 54 seconds left got the Blue Devils within 75-74. El-Amin, whose driving basket had given Connecticut the 75-72 lead, missed on a drive with 24 seconds left and Duke had life.

The crowd of 41,340 at Tropicana Field, the court where Duke's season ended a year ago, was roaring as the Blue Devils went for the final shot without calling a timeout.

Langdon, the fifth-year senior who made the Final Four in his last chance, tried to get by Ricky Moore, one of the game's best defenders. Langdon spun but Moore was there. Langdon took an extra step and was called for traveling with 5.4 seconds to go.

El-Amin made two free throws with 5.2 seconds left to get the lead back to 3, and Langdon's last chance at tying the game ended when he fell near the 3-point line and lost control of the ball.

With that, Connecticut charged the court and had the title everyone thought Duke would claim.

"We really worked hard as a team," Moore said. "I wanted to come out and prove myself. I wanted to show I have an offensive game as well as a defensive game. I wanted to shock the world."

It was Duke's eighth Final Four under Krzyzewski, who was trying to become the fourth coach to win a third national championship.

Calhoun, labeled one of the best coaches never to reach a Final Four, finally did, and left the court with a national title in his 27th season, the last 13 at Connecticut.

Duke finishes tied with the 1986 Duke team and UNLV in 1987 with 37 victories. The loss also gives Duke a 2-6 record in national championship games, the titles coming in 1991 and 1992.

This title was the first for the Big East since Villanova pulled off another huge upset in 1985, beating Georgetown.

A jumper by Hamilton gave the Huskies a 65-59 lead with 8:57 left. Elton Brand, the national player of the year who finished with 15 points and 13 rebounds, got Duke right back in it.

Brand blocked a shot by Hamilton then went down and scored on a fast break. He then stole the ball from Edmund Saunders 30 feet from the basket, but missed the free throw when he was fouled. After a basket by Chris Carrawell brought the Blue Devils within 65-63, Brand blocked a 3-point attempt by El-Amin and Langdon made one of two free throws on that possession to make it 65-64.

Hamilton, a first-team All-American who was 10-for-22 from the field and had seven rebounds, finished as the tournament's leading scorer with 145 points in the six games, a 24.1 average. He was the tournament's Most Outstanding Player.

Moore scored all 13 of his points in the first half and El-Amin had 12.

Langdon was 7-for-15 from the field, including 5-for-10 from 3-point range, and Avery had 11 points and five assists.

Duke's only other loss was by one point to Cincinnati in November and only four times did a team come within 10 points of the Blue Devils, who led the nation in scoring (92.3) and margin of victory (25.4).

Krzyzewski, who will have hip replacement surgery next week, is second on the NCAA tournament career victory list with 49.

One of those was in the 1990 regional final when Christian Laettner's buzzer beater on an inbounds play gave the Blue Devils a 79-78 overtime win over Connecticut.

There was no buzzer beater this time.

The Huskies finally got revenge in the last tournament of the decade.
